前言

由国家教育部 99 年度推出的全国公共英语等级考试(Public English Test System)(PETS)为中国英语考试社会化拉开一道全新的序幕,它使每个有志在英语学习上进阶、努力的人有了奋斗的目标。它打破了只有在校生才能获取一张英文水平等级证书的局面。中国也不再是只有大学英语四、六级考试一统天下的格局。PETS 考试为更多的有志者提供了方便和可能性,它更注重测定学生英语的实际应用能力。实在是可喜可庆之事。

国家教育部考试中心推出的 PETS 考试共分五级,大致为:一级相当于初中毕业生参加中考的英语水平;二级相当于高考的英语水平;三、四级相当于大学英语四、六级考试水平,拟替代成人英语自学考试;五级拟替代国家公派出国留学英语水平考试。本书作为 PETS 考试的同步辅导书,一~三级每级分别有“必备词汇”、“必备语法”、“阅读技巧”、“听力会话”和“考试自测”;四、五级分别为“语法、阅读解析”、“考试模拟自测”。

全套行家辅导 PETS 系列丛书均由熟悉 PETS 的行家执笔编写。它的特点是新、快、准。所谓“新”就是思路新,练习新;“快”是指学生使用时,上手快、掌握快;“准”是针对考试切题准。

《全国公共英语等级考试一级阅读技巧》一书是依据全国公共英语等级考试(PETS)大纲的要求而编写的。本书的阅读理解材料选自最新的国内外书刊,内容新颖,集知识性与娱乐性于一体,反映了现代社会中人们普遍关注的热点问题。本书特编有导读部分,介绍文章的相关背景知识,或某种阅读技巧。文章的编排遵循由浅入深的原则,对超出大纲的生词和词组,均作了注释。

此书有助于广大一级考生提高阅读理解能力,扩大知识面,同时也可作为广大在校初中毕业生中考英语的阅读辅导书。

Passage Five

Newspapers

Newspapers are usually published on a daily or weekly basis. Its main function is to report the news. Newspapers also provide remarks on the news, explain different public policies, give special information and advice to readers, and sometimes include features such as cartoons and serialized stories. In nearly all cases and in varying degrees, they depend on publication of commercial and advertising for their income.

With the development of radio broadcasting in the 1920s, and of television in the 1940s, newspapers still remain a major source of information on matters ranging from details of important news events to human-interest items.

In the U.S.A., for example, about 1700 daily newspapers print a total of 63 million copies, and almost every copy is read by at least two persons. Some 6800 weekly newspapers are also published with about 40 million copies. Newspaper publishers in the U.S.A. think that nearly 8 out of 10 adult Americans read a newspaper every day.
