对考研英语听力应试状况的分析

I. 考研学生在英语听力测试方面所面临的问题

研究生入学英语考试,以后将增加听力考项,这对绝大多数考生是个突如其来的大问题。不管是应届考生,或是在职考生,他们的学习和工作压力是人所共知的。据笔者了解,他们平时几乎没有搞什么听力训练。实际情况是,在大学一、二年级上英语课时,要通过大学英语四、六级考试,搞了一些听力训练。而从二年级末到毕业,几乎听力断了线,原来的那点水平已消失得差不多了。

上述是问题的一个方面。而另一个方面,从考研听力的试题状况看,仅就语篇的(字数)长度,就可以看出,听力考项是有相当难度的。

那么把上述两种情况放在一起分析,其反差之大是可想而知的。所以,可以断言,考研英语听力,在今年和以后的几年里,考生都会面临严峻的考验。

II. 有关考研听力, 考生要划清的几个界限

面临着严峻的局面,考生不能失去计划性,不能盲目准备,不能稀里糊涂地进考场。考生不管听力有多差,头脑要清醒,笔者建议考生要划清以下几个界限,

- 1. 自测一下自己的听力水平,估量一下自己的听力水平属于哪个层次。
- 2. 弄清基本功训练阶段的任务、应掌握的要领,以及要达到的目标。
- 3. 弄清应试中要掌握什么技巧,对这些技巧平时应如何加以训练。
- 4. 弄清楚考研英语听力的试题结构和内容,与大学英语四、六级听力及 TOEFL 听力的结构和内容各有什么区别。
- 5. 语言训练是综合性的,各个考项之间都有不同程度的相关性。听力理解的好坏,与基本词汇的熟练程度(会读、会写、听懂)、语法结构的掌握、语感的好坏,社会知识的多少,均有着一定的相关性。考生应弄清楚自己在这些方面的情况任何。

III. 准备参加考研的学生,在经过自测以后,要苦练听的实践能力

不论你的听力是好或是差,都要下一番苦功夫练习听的实际能力。没有最基本的听的能力,仅靠技巧是不行的。在练习听力的同时,要熟记(能听、能写)一级到三级的两千多个基本单词和常用短语(即大学英语大纲要求的,复用式掌握 2300 个),以及由这些单词构成的常用词组。

本书为那些听力不甚好的考生,提供了一部分从考研大纲的词汇表中筛选出来的词汇和短语,这些词汇是在考研大纲的词汇表的5000多个词汇之内,但属于大学英语的预备级、一级

到三级的词汇。本书还提供了一部分初级听力材料,让大家有个从初级到高级的过程。免得一上来就觉得难度很大,会丧失信心和兴趣,对练好听力是不利的。(但本书所提供的大部分材料是有相当难度的,只有经过大量而又有相当难度的训练才能收到真正的效果。)

临场应试技巧也是应该学一点的,特别是对那些听力差的同学。笔者发现,有的学生练了一阵子,也听了一些练习材料,但是,仍然无明显的进展,听起一篇短文来仍然模模糊糊,仅能听懂只言片语。这部分听力差的同学,他们也同样想拿到若干听力分值,那就不得不依靠一点临场的应试技巧了。

笔者从各种听力辅导书中看到,有关听力应试技巧的"高论"确实不少,笔者认为有相当一部分辅导书,虽然讲的头头是道,好像是既圆满又完美。但是,太琐碎,太面面俱到,学生很难有那么多的工夫,深入细致地研究应试技巧。应试技巧,应该是易学而有效。本书提供了一点应试技巧,仅此一点,不搞大而全,并配有训练材料。经多年实践,效果确有一些,一部分听力差的同学,学了该技巧后,他们确有喜出望外之感,考试成绩确有一定程度的提高。读者不妨练一练,以解燃眉之急。

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Unit One 分级自测

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简要说明

如前面所述,考研英语听力状况严峻。但是考生应清楚自己听力的状况属于哪个级别,只有知己知彼,才能百战不殆。因此,本单元设计八套听力试题,供考生自测之用。

这八套听力试题是参照考研听力试题的框架结构和要求设计的,同样分为 A、B、C 三个部分, A 部分是填表格; B 部分是完成句子; C 部分是多项选择的短文或长篇对话。这八套听力试题,按照难度共分为四个级别,每个级别两套试题。这四个级别是:

A级:模拟考研听力试题的难度,近似大学英语六级听力;

- B级:近似大学英语四级听力;
- C级:近似大学英语三级听力;
- D级:近似大学英语二级听力。

请读者认真做自测题,摸清自己的底细,脚踏实地,逐步攀登。

请读者注意,本单元一起提供了八套试题,虽然还未进入训练阶段,但仍要充分利用这八套试卷,进行第一个小循环的训练。在训练听力的过程中,听力训练材料总是宝贵的。
