前言

北京市华罗庚学校是由中国科学院华罗庚实验室、中国科技大学和中国人民大学附中联合创办的,是中国人民大学附中超常教育体系的重要组成部分。其办学目标是为国家大面积早期发现与培养现代杰出人才开辟一条切实可行的途径,为实施我国教育事业面向现代化、面向世界、面向未来的战略方针探索一种行之有效的方式。在这里,一大批高级教师、大学教授和研究员精心执教,一批批超常儿童茁壮成长。“华校”全体师生缅怀我国著名数学家华罗庚教授,崇尚他为国为民鞠躬尽瘁的高尚品质,决心沿着他的路继续走下去,在教育改革的时代大潮中争做弄潮儿,为实现中华民族重振雄风的宏图大业甘当马前卒。
