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# 高考英语听力

## 试题的回顾、现状与命题预测

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高考英语听力试题是为了考查考生理解口头英语的能力。其“演变”历程为：1997年，原国家教委开始了在增加听力测试的探索，由考试中心在广东省进行高考英语听力测试试点。1997年听力测试题的满分为20分，每小题1分，不计入总分。

1998年，听力测试题的满分为15分，每小题0.75分，成绩正式计入高考总分。

1999年，高考英语听力的卷面分值满分为30分，每小题1.5分，占全卷总分数(150分)的20%。

1997和1998年听力测试中的对话，每题选项都是四选一，而1999年则在试题总量不变的情况下，在前5小题中增加了单轮次的短对话，并将每题选项改为三选一。另外，1997和1998年听力试题中的每段录音均播放两遍，而从1999年起，听力试题前5段单轮次的小对话仅播放一遍，后面较长的对话、独白播放两遍。

自1999年起，高考的听力测试部分分为两节，第一节为5段单轮次的短对话，第二节为若干段含有3个轮次以上的长对话或独白，这种测试形式一直沿用至今。

2000年，教育部考试中心推出三套高考英语试卷：第一套含听力部分，听力占30分(共20小题，每小题1.5分)；第二套亦含听力部分，听力占20分(共20小题，每小题1分)；第三套不含听力部分。三套试卷卷面部分均为150分，供各地选用(上海、广东单独命题)。当时，全国有十多个省、市在高考英语中采用含听力测试的英语试卷，取消了不含听力的英语试卷或加试听力。

2001年，考试中心只向各省、市提供两套均含听力部分的英语高考试卷，取消了不含听力的高长英语试题，但各省、市仍可自行决定是否将听力部分成绩计入英语科总分。这一年听力测试已在全国推广到了近二十个省、市。

教育部计划从2000年开始以省为单位逐步过渡，争取用3年时间将听力测试推广到全国绝大多数地区，并规定2006年以后，任何省不得以任何理由拒绝在向考中增加听力测

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试。这对于当前的中学英语教学必然产生重大影响。因此,学习和研究高考英语中的听力测试题,对于高三毕业生乃至高一、高二的学生,都具有十分重要的现实意义。

录音文字材料的语言难度略低于阅读材料,采用对话和独白两种形式,全部采用口语体。材料中一般不会出现大纲以外的词汇,但个别不影响理解的词汇也有可能出现,但考生并不难理解这些词的意义。

通过对前几年试卷的分析,2003 年的高考英语试卷听力部分的命题将有如下趋势:

1. 材料的难度将低于阅读。

2. 词汇量将不超过教学大纲的要求。

3. 考核内容的难度也将低于阅读,而且只设三个选项。问题全部印在试卷上。问题的形式都为特殊疑问句,没有一般疑问句。

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# 时间、数字与计算

时间、数字与计算是听力测试中最常见的考项之一,了解该类试题的特点并掌握必要的解题方法至关重要。常见的计算题包括时间、价格、年龄、距离、速度等,往往要求进行简单的加、减、乘、除运算,而以加减计算题为主。所涉及的数字主要包括:日期、时间、年龄、价格、数量、距离、房号及电话号码等。就数字种类来说,主要有基数、序数、百分数、分数等。

例 1: What time does the train leave?

A. At 6:15.

B. At 6:25.

〔录音材料〕

M: I'm afraid we'll miss the train. What time is it now?

W: It's 6:15. There is 10 minutes left. Let's hurry.

〔分析〕:

答案选 B。此题考查时间判断与计算能力,根据女方所说的话 "It's 6:15. There are 10 minutes left." 可以判断火车是在 6:25 出发,此题要求考生具有听觉的连续性接受与联系能力。

例 2: At what time does the train to Leeds leave?

A. 3:00.

B. 3:15.

C. 5:00.

(高考 2001)

〔录音材料〕

W: Excuse me, could you tell me when the next train to Manchester is?

M: Sure, well, it's three now. The next train to Manchester leaves in two hours, but you can take a train to Leeds which leaves in fifteen minutes. And then get off at Manchester because it stops at Manchester on the way.



[分析]:

答案选 B。此题是考查时间的推断能力。答案 A 中的“3:00”是现在的时间,答话中两个小时后即 5 点钟开的火车是去 Manchester 的,但可以乘开往 Leeds 的火车,因为它经过 Manchester,而这次列车是 3:15 开的,因此正确答案为 B。

例 3: What is Tom's telephone number?

A. 680 - 6840.

B. 780 - 6842.

C. 780 - 7842.

M: Sally, here's a letter for us. It's from Tom.

W: Can you read it, please? My hands are wet with all this washing.

M: Well, OK. "Dear Sally and John, thanks for your letter. It was good to hear from you. Just a short note in reply. I was happy to hear that you two will be in town in January. I think that's the first time you will have come to visit us after your marriage. Please do call me when you arrive so that I can pick you up at the station. And then we may have dinner together in town. In case you don't have my phone number, it's 780 - 7842. I look forward to meeting you soon. Yours, Tom."

[分析]:

答案选 C。此题考查考生对对话中时间的捕捉能力。只要听清了"It's 780 - 7842."便能答对此题。

例 4: What is the woman's house number?

W: Excuse me, but I think you made a wrong turn. You are supposed to turn left on Wilson Boulevard.

M: Why don't I just make a U-turn at the corner?

W: Well, you shouldn't make a U-turn there. It's a one-way street. See the sign ahead?

M: Well, maybe if I turn left here, I can come down the next street.

W: You can't do that either during rush hour. Really though, don't go to any trouble. Sometimes, one can wait thirty minutes for a taxi. So I am happy to get this close.

M: Thirty minutes? I've been riding around all day looking for passengers.

[分析]:

— 2 — 答案选 B。此题考查细节理解能力。1323 Wilson 是男方要找的地方,但这并不是女方的家,从女方的第一句话可判断,男方找到女方的家是找错地方了,女方家的号码是 3023。

## 【解题思路与技巧】

来,送你一个好心情!



在解这类试题时,不仅要听清楚录音中的数字,还要听清楚表明数字间关系的词,因为这类词是确定运算方法的关键和依据。时间、数字与计算类的题型都涉及数字,很多时候涉及不只一个数字,故做题时得反映敏捷,可以利用选择项做笔记。
