

编写说明

本书配合现行全国统编教材高级中学英语课本第一册,是以练习形式编写的学习参考书。为了能较好地达到"加强基础、发展智力、培养能力"这一目的,本书为广大中学师生和英语自学者提供了大量形式多样的双基训练和综合提高练习,力求做到激发学生兴趣,开拓学生思路,启发学生积极思维,促使并帮助学生不断归纳整理知识,使用已学知识。

本书的内容分成以下几个部分:

一、试卷 试卷(1)安排在本书的开头,是根据初中英语课本1—6册的主要内容命题的。读者可以自测对初中阶段课本内容掌握的情况,便于顺利进入高中阶段的学习。试卷(2)安排在本书的最后,是根据高中英语课本第一册的要求命题的。读者可以自测学完第一册后的水平。

二、课文练习

- 1. 理解题 理解题是根据课文设计的,读者应该在看完 全篇课文后做这项练习,以训练自己掌握全文主要内容的能力,和根据上下文猜测部分生词、词组意义的能力。
- 2. **词汇学习** 这部分练习包括构词、课文生词和 词 组 操练、常用词汇学习等内容。读者要注意单词的读音、词形(拼写)、词义和搭配关系。
 - 8. 句型学习/就课文中出现的常用句型套用操练。

4. 语法学习

- 5. **补充读物** 本书尽量选用了与课文内容、 体栽相近的读物。读者阅后可做文后的理解测试题, 以益查自己的阅读理解能力。
- 6. 看图说话 每篇课文后都配上了几幅图画。读者可以 用学过的语言知识,用自己的话看图复述课文,以提高口头 表达能力。也可看图作文,锻炼写作能力。
- 7. **想象** 读者可以充分发挥自己的想象力, 用口头或 笔头形式完成此题。
- 三、复习练习 根据语法项目,把全册分成四个单元,分别有四个复习练习。每个复习练习都包括语音(单词)、词汇、句型和语法几方面的内容。既有句的练习,也有篇的练习。

对于高中英语课本第一册中出现的语言要点和难点,本 书还根据中学生的实际水平作了注释。本册练习中打△号的 题目屬较高要求,读者可选择使用。

本学习参考另配答案一本,其中有些答案不是唯一答案, 仅供参考。

本书编写过程中,蒙上海市教育局教研室陈少敏同志关心和指导,谨在此致以深切的谢意。

由于编者水平有限,书中不免有错误不当之处,欢迎读者批评指正。
