

## 前言

英语专业自学课《综合英语》是 1999 年采用的新教材,由于此类辅导资料少,课程难度大,学生平时有限的时间都用于对课本知识的理解和掌握,几乎没有考前强化训练的资料,针对这一现象,作者通过这两年来对新教材的教授与研究并结合多年来的英语教学经验编写了《综合英语(一)上册考前强化训练及题解》、《综合英语(一)下册考前强化训练及题解》、《综合英语(二)下册考前强化训练及题解》。它们是作者在认真研究全国高等教育自学考试指导委员会发布的《综合英语自学考试大纲》、《综合英语》自学考试教材、《英语专业自学课程词汇表》以及《大学英语教学大纲通用词汇表(1-4 级)》的基础上,结合教学实际对教学中发现的学生容易出现的问题系统整理和分析后编写出来的。旨在帮助读者通过大量的考前模拟强化训练作到有备而战,从而顺利通过考试。

本书具有以下几个特点:

- 一、题型新。每套题都是严格按照最新颁布的全国高等教育自学考试英语专业《综合英语》课程考试大纲的新题型的要求而设计编写。
- 二、取材范围广,针对性强。词汇、语法部分涵盖所有课文中的 重要单词、词组和语法现象;课文理解(包括课文内容填空与课文句 子释义)、写作题和翻译部分也都包括了教材的所有篇章内容;课外 阅读理解、完型填空部分选材广泛,内容涉及生活中的许多方面以及 自然科学和社会科学的多个领域,有助于提高阅读能力。
- 三、试题难易程度适中。试题完全按照最新公布的全国高等教育自学考试英语专业《综合英语》课程考试说明要求的比例,即:易 20%、较易 30%、较难 30%、难 20%。

四、题解详尽、准确。每套题都有精解,帮助考生复习巩固所学

语言知识。

本书不仅适用于参加英语专业自学考试的考生,同时适用于其他各专业的自学人才。对于普通高等学校以及各类成人高等学校学生来说,也是一本不可多得的课外阅读和练习的材料。对于本书中可能出现的问题,希望广大读者加以指正并提出宝贵意见,以使本书更加完善。

### Passage 1

All plant cells are capable of taking up water. Even dead ones do to a certain degree. Absorption of water by dead cell walls makes wood swell. In common land plants, the living cells of roots take up most of the water. Land plants without roots do exist, however. Those greenish-yellow lichens you see on tree trunks and on rocks in the high mountains have no roots. A half a billion years ago, when water plants started to invade the land, the first primitive land plants did not have roots; they were marsh plants.

Even among the flowering plants, one finds rootless forms. These flowering plants are the so-called higher plants because they evolved more recently and are thus considered higher on the evolutionary scale. In the Peruvian desert, there grows one of these rootless higher plants, a bromeliad. It is a relative of the pineapple. Even if this plant had roots, they would be of no use, because where the plant grows, it never rains. The plant gets its water only from the dew it collects at night, when its leaves cool off. Such rootless plants, of course, can be moved with ease, but they will only grow when they are placed out in the open. If they are placed too near a house, the radiation from the heat of the house prevents the leaves from cooling and so prevents dew from forming, and the plant dies. In the southern United States and in Puerto Rico, one sees bromeliads growing high above the streets on the insulation (绝缘体) of electric wires. These plants obtain their water from rain, and the only soil they ever come in contact with is the dust that may blow on their leaves.

## Passage 2

In any survival situation, the question of locating food will be extremely important but is much less vital than the task of finding water. It may not be pleasant to think about but in an emergency you will find that many unconventional creatures are edible, and are eaten by the local inhabitants, who are experts in knowing how to live off the land. In the process, you will have to forget many of your civilized prejudices (偏见).

There is plenty of good food in the tropics, enough to sustain you almost indefinitely. There is food from plants and trees and there are animals, birds, fish, snakes and lizards of many kinds. All of them are good to eat. The meat from the hindquarters and tail of the lizard makes a delicious meal. The iguana is also a delicacy much sought after by jungle gourmets (食物品尝家). All jungle animals should be cooked in order to kill the parasites and improve the taste.

All snakes are edible but they are not found as frequently as is

commonly supposed. They taste much like the white meat of chicken although the flesh is a bit stringy and slightly salty. In preparing snakes and lizards, skin, remove the viscera, and cook as you would any other meat.

In the dense rain forest, most of the animals are high in the trees, out of sight and reach. There are few animals on the forest floor. Usually it is limited to land crabs, land turtles, lizards and snakes. The larger animals and birds of the rain forest make the best eating in an emergency but they are difficult to catch. Most people will walk through a tropical forest without ever seeing game of any kind even though it may be there in large amounts. Too much reliance should not be placed on the larger animals as a source of food.
