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前 言

- 听力理解
- ⊙ 词汇结构
- 阅读理解与翻译
- 完形填空与简答
- 写 作

丛书是根据"大学英语教学大纲(修订版)"、"大学英语四级考试大纲"的要求精心编写的,以各类测试题为主,考生可根据自身的实际情况,有选择地进行某方面的强化训练,最终达到提高综合能力之目的。

本书为(词汇结构)分册,全书的主要内容 及特点是:

- ① 重点、难点解析。本书的前两部分为词汇、语法精讲,主要是针对英语学习中较易遇到的词汇和语法方面的问题,从历年的四级真题中精选出重点和难点题,进行详细的分析与讲解,总结出一些行之有效的学习方法和应试技巧。
- ②强化训练。书的前两部分附有大量的词汇和语法真题及模拟试题,第三部分为词汇结构综合模拟试题。全书共有测试题 1200 多道,意在通过强化训练,使考生熟练掌握词汇、语法知识,提高应试能力。
- ③ 简明评析。所有试题,在给出参考答案的基础上,都予以简明扼要的讲解、评析, 既突出重点,又给学生们留下思考的余地。

参加本书编写的还有郭湛然、牟维静、吕 建多、李辉、李群英、范文静、张红、姚小岚 等。

由于作者水平、经验有限,书中难免有错 误或不妥之处,恳请广大读者批评指正。

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第1部分

河 汇

学习任何一门语言,词汇总是最为重要的。词汇量的多少是衡量人们对某种语言掌握程度的主要标准,因此词汇题是大学英语四级考试中必考的内容。这部分考试内容的目的是测试学生运用词汇、短语的能力。词汇题贯穿于大学英语四级考试的各个部分,所以只有打下比较扎实的词汇基础,才能全面获得高分。

一般说来,如果熟悉大学英语四六级词汇表,不仅能记住其中单词的意思,同时还能掌握它们的用法,那么解答词汇题时就不会有太大的困难。但是,要在限定的时间内迅速而准确地答题,也非易事。因此在学习中要注意弄清出题类型,做一些有针对性的练习,才能有的放矢。

分析历次大学英语四级考试试题可以看出,词汇题大体分为五大类:同义或近义词,近形异义词,同源词,短语,难词辨析。本部分围绕这五类词汇题,从历次大学英语四级考试全真试题、硕士研究生入学考试、TOEFL 全真试题以及其他试题中精心挑选出了一些词汇题进行详细的解释,并且针对各类词汇题配有相应的练习,希望英语学习者能够凭借此书,了解英语四级考试词汇题类型,并且能够进行自测,检查自己的学习成果,提高自己的答题技巧。

1.1 选项为同义词或近义词

该题型的特点是四个选项为意思很接近的词,如果不仔细分析,不了解它们的细微差别就很难确定哪个选项是正确的,做这种题时要注意以下两个方面的差异。

1.1.1 搭配方面的差异

- 例 1: She was so ____ in her job that she didn't hear anybody knocking at the door. (1996年1月)
- A) attracted B) absorbed C) drawn D) concentrated 答案为 B。 be absorbed in 为固定搭配, 意为"专心致志做某事"。其他选项与不同词构成短语也有专心致志做某事的含义, 但搭配不同。如: attract /draw sb.'s attention to sth.; concentrate on sth.。
 - 例 2: He ____ me with negligence of duty.
- A) accused B) blamed C) charged D) indicted 答案为 C。charge sb. with sth. 为固定搭配。这四个动词的词义相近,都可用来表示"指责,指控",但搭配不同。如: accuse sb. of sth.; blame/indict sb. for sth.。

1.1.2 内涵方面的差异

- 例 1: The strong storm did a lot of damage to the coastal villages; several fishing boats were _____ and many houses collapsed.
 - A) wrecked B) spoiled C) torn D) injured

答案为 A。wrecked 意为"使(船,火车等)失事"; spoiled 意为"损坏,糟蹋,笼坏"; torn 意为"撕开,拉掉,使分裂"; injured 意为"损害,伤害"。因此 A 项正确。
