

### 译者前言

本词典根据(英国)彼得·科林出版公司第二版译出。译本采取双解的形式,一般词条给出汉语对应词,读者可同时借助英语释义理解词条的含义。本词典中释义所用的英语词汇量控制在500个单词以内,词条例句丰富,读者可据此学习该词条的具体用法。另有大量的带有百科知识性的注解(Comments)对理解词条有很大的帮助;而 Notes 则对该词的用法、在美国英语中的形式等进行了说明。

本词典收词多、词汇新。词典中共收录了9,100余个相关的词条,且新词特别多,很多是同类词典中所难查到的。如 EGA 等电子出版专业术语及 e-mail 等目前信息时代用词也是首次被收录在此类专业词典中。

本词典涵盖了出版印刷业的各个领域。在欧洲,自谷登堡(GUT-TENBERG)发明现代印刷技术之后,纸制图书阅读迅速成为人们学习、娱乐的最重要的方式之一。随着现代科学技术的发展,出版印刷业发生了质的变化,电子多媒体产品相继面市。目前,网络出版也成为全球出版业在探讨的热门话题。20世纪六七十年代,欧美出版业的大规模兼并加快了出版业全球化的进程,并将先进的管理模式带入了出版业。为了适应目前出版印刷业的发展,本词典收录了编辑、排版、印刷、仓储、市场营销、企业管理、财会、税务、运输、计算机等领域的词汇。

本词典在翻译过程中力求译名的准确和规范。译者参考了国内出版的新的词典,如中国出版印刷研究所编写的《出版印刷词汇》、中国计算机学会编写的《计算机词汇》和朗文清华《英汉双解科学技术词典》等,在此表示衷心的感谢。

随着我国加入 WTO,全球化进程的加速,我国出版业同仁势必将有很多机会与国外同行进行交流,我们希望这本词典能成为大家沟通的纽带。

COMMENT: Paper is a relatively absorbent substrate because there are pores in between the fibres and mineral particles. Liquids such as oil or water can be absorbed through these pores. Water absorbency and oil absorbency are quite different properties, and as most printing inks are oil-based, the printer is more concerned with the oil absorbency of paper than its water absorbency. Oil absorbency can be measured using the PIRA Surface Oil Absorbency Tester (SOAT), the K & N method or the IGT method.

account book noun ledger in which accounts are kept 账本: accountbook binding = binding style which is used for books which are to be written in, and therefore must lie flat when open (also called 'stationery binding') 账本 装订

accounting noun work of recording money paid, received, borrowed or owed 会计(工作): accounting period = period usually covered by a firm's accounts 会计结算期; cost accounting = preparing special accounts of manufacturing and sales costs 成本会计; current cost accounting = method of accounting which notes the cost of replacing assets at current prices, rather than valuing assets at their original cost 现行成本会计,当期成本会计 accredited adjective (agent) who is appointed by a company to act on its behalf 被委派的

acct = ACCOUNT 账目,账户

acetate noun sheet of transparent film used for marking the designer's instructions, for placing CRC, for making overlays or for laminating a glossy book cover; proofs can also be taken from acetates 醋酸纤维素胶片,醋酸盐(酯): The colour separations are on acetate.分色片是以醋酸纤维素胶片为介质水。

achromatic adjective without any colour 无色的; achromatic colour = (grey) colour within the range between black and white displayed by a graphics adapter 消色, 无彩色(指白、灰黑色); achromatic separations = colour separations on a scanner by using the very minimum of primary colours and adding black 消色差分色(使用极少量原色,加重黑色的分色方法)

acid noun chemical compound containing hydrogen, which reacts with analkali to form a salt and water, and turns litmus paper red; acids are used to etch printing plates 酸: acid-free

paper = paper which has had certain acid chemicals removed; if they are left in, the paper will become yellow and brittle with age; acid-free paper is used to wrap and preserve documents and other works of art which might be affected by the acid in normal wrapping paper 无酸纸; acid process = process of making chemical paper pulp using acid (制造纸浆时的)酸处理过程

acknowledge verb to tell a sender that a letter or package or shipment has arrived 告知收到: He has still not acknowledged my letter of the 24th.他一直未告知收到我 24 日的信。We acknowledge receipt of your order of June 14th.我们通知你 6 月 14 日的订单已收到。

acknowledgement noun (a) act of acknowledging 回扶,(收到的)确认通知: She sent an acknowledgement of receipt.她发了回执。They sent a letter of acknowledgement.他们寄信确认已收到。(b) acknowledgements = text printed at the beginning of a book, where the author or publisher thanks people who have helped in its preparation (书前的)致谢

COMMENT: The acknowledgements may also include references to institutions which have given permission to quote copyright material or to use copyright photographs. The acknowledgements are usually placed after the verso of the title page and before the preface; if short, they can be listed at the end of the preface itself. 注解:书籍前的致谢还可以包括注明那 些许可使用其资料或照片的机构。致谢 通常排在扉页的背面、序言前;如果很短, 还可以把它放在序言末。

acoustic adjective referring to sound 声音的: acoustic hood = soundproof hood placed over a printer to reduce the noise (印刷机的)声音減噪壳

acoustic coupler noun device that

connects to a telephone handset, converting binary computer data into sound signals to allow data to be transmitted down a telephone line 声音 耦合器

COMMENT: The acoustic coupler also converts sound signals back to digital signals when receiving messages; it is basically the same as a modem but uses a handset on which a loudspeaker is placed to send the signals rather than direct connection to the phone line. It is portable, and clips over both ends of a normal telephone handset; it can be used even in a public phone booth.

Acrobat<sup>TM</sup> noun file format (developed by Adobe Systems) that describes a graphics, text and indexing system that allows the same screen image or page layout file to be displayed on different hardware; for

example, an Acrobat file can be viewed on a Macintosh and a PC or from Internet browsers such as NetScape Acrobat 文档格式

**acronym** noun abbreviation, usually formed from the initial letters of a group of words, which make up a word which can be pronounced 首字母简写,首字母缩写词: The acronym RAM means Random Access Memory.简写的RAM 意思为随机存取寄存器。

acute adjective (a) very sharp or clear (image)(形象)轮廓分明的;精明的, 敏锐的; (b) acute accent = small sign (or) placed above a vowel to show that it is pronounced in a special way or to indicate stress 元音字母上的 重音标志

ad noun informal = ADVERTISE-MENT广告: We put an ad in the paper.我们在报纸上刊登了广告。She answered an ad in the paper.她与广告上要求的相符。He found his job through an ad in the paper.他是通过报纸上的一则广告找到工作的。coupon ad = advertisement with a form attached, which is to be cut out and returned to the advertiser with your name and address for further information 附有回执格式的广告; display ad = DISPLAY ADVERTISEMENT 以醒目方式刊载的广告

adapt verb to change a work so that it fits a different medium or market 改编: The novel has been adapted for television.那部小说被改编成了电视剧。

He wants to adapt the textbook for the American market.他想改编那个课本以适合美国市场需要。

adaptation noun work which has been adapted 改编: He paid \$50,000 for the screen adaptation.他为改编成电影剧本付了 50,000 美元。His adaptation of the novel was turned down by the editorial board.他对小说的改编遭到了编委会的否决。

adapter or adaptor noun (a) person who has done an adaptation 改编者: He was the adapter of the novel for the TV series.他把那部小说改编成电视连续剧。(b) device that allows two or more incompatible devices to be connected together 转接器: graphics adapter = electronic device (normally on an expansion card) in a computer that converts software commands into electrical signals that display graphics on a connected monitor 图像转接器

add verb (a) to put figures together to make a total 加,加起来: to add home and export sales 将国内销售额和出口销售额加起来; (b) to put things together to make a large group 增添: We are adding to the sales force.我们在不断的增加销售力量。They have added two new lists to their range of homecare titles.他们在他们的"家庭关护"系列增添了两个栏目。

**added entry** *noun* secondary file entry in a library catalogue 图书馆目录中的次要文件条目

addendum noun text which is added (such as late copy, which reaches the publisher after the main text has been printed and is added as a supplement) 补遗,附录: He attached an addendum to the contract.他签署了合同的附加本。
The encyclopaedia appeared with twenty pages of addenda.大百科全书新增加了 20 页的附录。(NOTE: plural is addenda)

addition noun (a) thing or person

addressing machine noun machine which puts addresses on envelopes automatically 贴地址机

adhere verb to stick to something 黏着,附着

adhesion noun ability to stick 附着力 adhesive 1 noun glue, substance which sticks 黏合剂,胶粘剂: The company has developed a range of adhesives for perfect binding.那个公司开发 了一系列装订用的胶。The books are bound using special adhesive for tropical climates. 热带地区的书用特殊的胶 粘。hot melt adhesive = binding glue which is heated before being used 热熔胶粘剂; spray adhesive = glue in an aerosol can, which is used for pasting up artwork and allows the designer to reposition the artwork if necessary 喷雾胶粘剂 2 adjective which sticks 带黏性的: The posters are stuck to the back of the stand with adhesive
