### 前言

英语语法选择题是历年高考中的重要项目。它涉及英语语法各方面的知识,并检验学生掌握的熟练程度。因此一向受到广大师生的高度重视,为了迎考,考生们不惜投入大量精力和时间进行训练。有鉴于此,作者精心编写了这本专项训练,以飨读者。
