- ▶ 凡是全真试题中出现过的题型都可能是再次考试的考点。 结论:"考过的是题解"。
 - ▶"同义替换往往是答案"。
 - ▶ "but 后面有題眼"。
 - ▶ "听到的不是题解"。
 - ▶"概括性的是題解"。

于是我们的编写设想出台了:第一,学生介入写作过程中.教 师按策划要求选出所有的试题,首先发到学生中去,由学生做,然 后教师再收上来在批阅中寻找写作重点,从各个角度和各个层面 尽可能地使不同层次的考生都能从我们的书中有所收获。第二、 教师的写作重点体现在对解题思路的点拨和知识的拓展方面。

这样,教与学双方的互动都在本丛书中得到了很好的体现。

-在丛书的特色

著名英语语言学习专家和应试专家钟道降教授在他的一次讲 座中表述了这样的观点,模拟题只能检验学生的水平,不能提高学 生的水平。效度高的模拟题只要做一两套就可以了,关键是从中 找到自己的差距。基于此种观点,我们把每本书的结构分成两大 块:第一部分,真题在线,目的是用足用透真题。采取一题一解的 形式,让学生从信度极高的真题中找寻自己的不足,给学生的复习 提出指导性建议。第二部分,名题点击,采取少而精的原则选编模 拟题,让学生检测自己的水平,在整套题后做出注释。高手们的高 招自始至终贯穿在全书的内容中。


