Henry Ford



Henry Ford was the first 5 person to build cars which 9 were cheap, strong, and 13 fast. He was able to sell 18 millions of models becau-21 he 'mass-produced' 24 them; that is, he made a 30 great many cars of exactly 35 the same type. Ford's 39 father hoped that his son 44 53

would become a farmer, but the young man did not like the idea and he went to Detroit where he worked as a mechanic (技工). By the age of 29, in 1892, he had built his first car. However, the first 'mass-produced' car in the world, the famous 'Model T', did not appear until 1908 — five years after Ford had started his great Motor Company (公司). This car proved to be so popular (受欢迎的) that it remained unchanged for twenty years. Since Ford's time, mass-production methods have become common in industry and have reduced


