### 内容简介

《大学英语词汇练习》是一套英语词汇学习丛书,它根据《大学英语教学大纲》中的3,484个单词以及由这些单词构成的近千条常用词组,从目前国内外大学所采用的英语教科书、原版读物和辞书中精选了各类例句,由浅入深、循序惭进地分成六级。本书是这套丛书中的第三级,含有590个单词,160个词组,分十个单元,每单元分五个学习环节。书中突出了所要重点掌握的词汇,形式灵活多样,兼容并蓄,具有一定的科学性、实用性和趣味性。

本丛书可与目前根据《大学英语教学大纲》编写的任何一套教材配套使用;对 各类大专院校文、理科学生,研究生,进修生以及具有一定程度的自学者都有一定 的使用和参考价值。

## 前 言

《大学英语词汇练习》是根据《大学英语教学大纲》规定的词汇编写而成的一套系统的词汇学习丛书。按照《大纲》,分六级教学的要求,该书分六册编写出版。在编写过程中,我们首先参考了国内外的权威性词汇论著,如 "Cambridge Lexicon" (Roland Hindmarch), "A General Service List of English Words" (Michael West), 《英语基本词汇》(高名凯,刘正埮)。然后对照了国内大学目前正在使用的教材,如上海外语学院编写的专业用《英语》,上海交通大学编写的理工科和文理通用英语教科书,并且结合我们的教学体会和学生的特点,最后定量、定性地,由浅入深地将

《大纲》中的 3 4 8 4 个单词以及由这些单词构成的近千条 常用词组分成六级。每级单词和常用词组具体分配数如表 1 所示。

每册的词汇又按词性平均分为十个单元。每个单元包含 五个练习环节(如表 2 所示)。例句均选自目前国内外大学 所采用的英语教科书、原版读物和辞书,题材广泛,难度适 中。练习突出了所要重点掌握的词汇,形式灵活多样,兼容 并蓄,具有一定的科学性、实用性和趣味性。

众所周知,若要掌握好英语。词汇学习乃是至关重要的。然而,要学好词汇,则必须在两个方面下功夫:一是不断扩大词汇量;二是不断地加深对所学词汇的理解,以达到在听、说、读、写中运用自如的程度。要做到这一点,就必须不断练习,反复实践。我们正是本着这种实践第一的原则。选择了大量生动活泼的语言学习素材,创造了丰富多彩的练习形式,以帮助学生扎扎实实地掌握《大纲》所要求的,也是每个英语学习者必须掌握的基本词汇,促进整个英语水平的提高。

该丛书可与目前根据《大学英语教学大纲》编写的任何一套教材配套使用。教师可将其作为词汇专册,组织课堂教学,学生则可将其作为课内外词汇学习的练习册使用,既适用于理工科学生,也适用于文科学生。由于本书遵循了由浅入深、循序渐进、逐级编写、分册出版的原则,所以适合各类大专院校不同程度的学生使用。此外,本书对各类研究生、进修生以及具有一定程度自学者都有一定的使用和参考价值。
