

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前　　言

本书是配合《新英语教程》(New English Course) **英语阅读** (Guided Reading) 第五册而编写的教师参考书 (Teacher's Book)。和 1—4 册教师参考书不同, 第 5 册教参将 A、B 分册合编成一册, 构成下列内容, 以利教师和学生参阅使用。

KEY TO EXERCISES(由原教材编者提供)
