Introduction

If music is the "food of love", then *listening* is the "food of oral communication". Before beginning to speak, it is important for students to listen to as much as they can in English.

Students need modelled English conversations to develop their speaking skills, but finding relevant ones can be difficult. Many teachers will often suggest to students that they collect dialogues, both to enhance their listening and to study the grammar structures of conversational English. However, when students, living in a non-English speaking country, ask teachers where to get these dialogues, the issue becomes more complex. Oral English textbook dialogues are often either very social or functional conversations which sound artificial. Movie dialogues are more authentic sounding, but they are also very contextual. Radio and TV programs in English often contain either monologues or overly formal factual dialogues, which are of little use to the student preparing for an interview type conversation like IELTS. What dialogues can teachers suggest that would help students prepare for a specific interview? Aside from the few sample interviews in various self-study textbooks, teachers have, unfortunately, had to rely on a very small and inadequate selection.

This textbook gives beginner level students a collection of dialogues as a way of preparing to speak. The dialogues involve an interviewer and candidate, and are modelled after typical IELTS speaking exams. Each chapter involves a topic that is typically asked in the IELTS exam. The speaking exercises give students a model way of practicing each topic.

A typical structure to each chapter involves

1. Pre-listening vocabulary

- 2. Pre-listening questions
- 3. Pre-listening expressions
- 4. 3 dialogues with listening exercises
- 5. Speaking exercises

The exercises are merely to make sure students concentrate more. Neither the dialogues nor the exercises are particularly difficult; they follow the typical flow and content of an interview. The main purpose of the exercises is to help students get used to the patterns of IELTS styled dialogues, and to give them the necessary experience in listening to native speakers. Each chapter involves a topic that is typically asked in the IELTS exam.

It is recommended that students progress through each chapter and then, when finished with the book, go on to study more advanced level dialogues. As a whole, this book can be used repeatedly as a way to build love of English sound patterns. Until such sound is appreciated and enjoyed, English will remain a burden. I hope this book frees all students from such a burden.

Preface and Acknowledgement

This book was developed to help those students who need IELTS style dialogues as models, but are still at an early stage of English listening comprehension and speaking skills.

I would like to thank the students who studied IELTS during the first half of 2002 at the New Oriental School; they provided our school with the inspiration for such a book.

Additionally, I would like to thank the staff of the IELTS department, and Mr. Hu Min, the general editor, President of the New Oriental School. He was the founder of the IELTS department, and key in providing the proper direction for the book and for ensuring that it contains the best in quality. His collection of published materials on IELTS is unrivalled in China.
