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## 前 言

"英语泛听"是根据国家教育委员会审定批准的《大学英语教学大纲》的要求及教学的实际需要而编写的英语泛听教材。目的在于为学生提供一个实用的泛听环境,帮助学生进行专门的英语听力训练,有助于通过四级统考的听力测验,逐渐提高学生英语听力技能,从而使学生切实达到"大纲"所规定的听力水平。

本教材分上、下两册,由学生用书和教师用书配套组成,每册分为15个单元,每单元均由三部分组成,每个单元分别围绕一个主题。内容生动有趣、题材广泛多样,课文由浅入深,由易至难,题型种类多样,具有容量大、内容新、形式多样的特点,系统地反映了当代英美日常用语及基础科技用语,因而有很强的实用性。特别是在听力训练方法上,更体现了独到之处。

本教材由专家审稿,由北京师范学院大学英语部王凤英、刘宝芬、孙小芬编写。由美籍专家录音,语音语调标准、清晰、优美。语速适度,适合于大学非英语专业的学生及具有相应水平的英语爱好者提高听力使用。


