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



China). It takes up the southern part of North America and stretches from the Pacific to the Atlantic. It also includes Alaska in the north and Hawaii in the Pacific Ocean. The total area of the country is about nine and a half million square kilometres. The USA borders on Canada in the north and on Mexico in the south. It also has a sea-border with Russia.

The USA is made up of 50 states and the District of Columbia, a special federal area where the capital of the country, Washington, is situated. The population of the country is more than 270 million.

If we look at the map of the USA, we can see lowlands and mountains. The highest mountains are the



Rocky Mountains, the Cordillera and the Sierra Nevada. The highest peak (山峰) is Mount McKinley which is located in Alaska.

America's largest rivers are the Mississippi, the Missouri, the Rio Grande and the Columbia. The Great Lakes on the border with Canada are the largest and deepest in the USA.

The climate of the country varies (变化) greatly. The coldest regions are in the North. The climate of Alaska is very cold. The climate of the central part is continental. The South has a subtropical (亚热带的) climate. Hot winds blowing from the Gulf of Mexico often bring hurricanes (飓风). The climate along the Pacific coast is much warmer than that of the Atlantic coast.

The largest cities are: New York, Los Angeles, Chicago, Philadelphia, Detroit, San Francisco, Washington and others.

Ernest Hemingway was one of the greatest American writers of the 20th century. He was born in 1899 in Oak Park, Illinois. At school he played football and wrote for the school newspaper.

In 1917, when the United States entered the First World War, Hemingway left home and school to become a young reporter for the Kansas City Star. He wanted to join the army, but was refused because of an eye injury from football. Finally he managed to go to Europe as an ambulance (教护车) driver for the Red Cross. He joined the Italian army and was seriously wounded.

His war experience and adventurous life provided the background for his many short stories and novels. He achieved success with *A Farewell to Arms*, the story of a love affair between an American army officer and an English nurse during the First World War.

Hemingway actively supported the Republicans in the Spanish Civil War and wrote another successful novel of war, love and death. It was For Whom the Bell Tolls.

During the Second World War Hemingway was a war reporter first in China and then in Europe. He fought in France, and helped to liberate Paris.

In his later years Hemingway lived mostly in Cuba where his strong feeling for deep-seafishing provided the background for *The Old Man and the Sea*. He was awarded the Nobel Prize for literature in 1954.
