。内容简介。

为了帮助学生复习巩固高中阶段所学的词汇,适应高 考词汇的新要求,培养学生自学及运用语言的能力,我们 根据新教学大纲精神及现行英语教科书编写了此书,它具 有以下几方面特点:

- 一、本书的基础单词是按高三阶段所学词汇及语法知识,以单元为单位,将重点,难点的单词和词组通过中英文解释、例句、固定短语搭配、词汇扩展、近义、反义词等手段,使读者对所学单词的用法一目了然,也利于读者学习记忆,达到边学边掌握的目的。
- 二、为了体现新教学大纲"侧重培养阅读能力,并使学生获得一定的自学能力",本书涵盖了高考必备的重点短语,还补充了一部分考纲上没有但很常用的短语、附有中英文解释,并举出了例句,不仅能帮助读者准确地理解这些短语,同时也扩充了词汇量,培养了对词汇及句型的理解认知能力,从而逐渐提高阅读速度和理解能力。
- 三、在每部分的单词和词组讲解后都附有精辟的单词 和词组填充练习,以便读者及时巩固消化所学词汇。练习 后附有答案,便于及时查对。

四、为了便于读者在学习过程中集中查阅,本书后附 有按字母顺序排列的索引,读者可以根据书后的索引查阅 有关单词和词组。

总之,本书是一部集释义、惯用、搭配、构词为一体的多功能词汇参考书,是中学生学习新教材迎接高考的必备工具,也是培养阅读能力,提高自学能力的可靠帮手,同时也为广大中学教师提供了备课的素材。

由于编者水平有限,时间仓促,书中错误之处在所难 免,敬请广大读者批评指正。
