II. Competition Information

1. Dates

The archery competitions for the 10th Asian Games will be held in Seoul from September 27 through September 30, 1986.

2. Venues

2.1. Competition Site

The archery competition will take place on the Hwarang Archery Field at the Korea Military Academy, 18km from the Asian Games Village.

The seating capacity of the Hwarang Archery Field will be for approximately 1,500 spectators. Seats will be reserved for members of the Asian Games Family. Technical facilities will be in compliance with the FITA specifications. Offices for the Jury, Secretariat and the Seoul Asian Games Organizing Committee (SAGOC) will also be provided at the competition site.

2.2. Training Site

Archers will be able to train at the Hwarang Archery Training Field adjacent to the competition site. A sufficient number of targets at each distance of the FITA rounds will be available and will be allocated in accordance with the training schedule.

3. Events

The competitions will comprise a double FITA round. A FITA round consists of 36 arrows from each distance. There will be six (6) events for women and six (6) events for men as follows:

3.1. Women

Individual

- Double FITA Round at 70, 60, 50 and 30m.
- Double FITA Round at 70m.
- Double FITA Round at 60m.
- Double FITA Round at 50m.
- Double FITA Round at 30m.

Team

Double FITA Round at 70, 60, 50 and 30m.

3.2. Men

Individual

- Double FITA Round at 90, 70, 50 and 30m.
- Double FITA Round at 90m.
- Double FITA Round at 70m.
- Double FITA Round at 50m.
- Double FITA Round at 30m.

5. Equipment

All equipment and installations will comply with the FITA Rules. Targets at competition and training sites will be supplied by Bengston (SWE).

III. General Rules and Regulations

1. Rules

The 10th Asian Games archery competitions will be conducted in accordance with the Constitution and Rules of the International Archery Federation (FITA). In case of disagreement in the interpretation of the Rules, the English text shall prevail. Any unforeseen incidents not covered by the Rules will be dealt with as follows:

- **1.1.** Cases of a general nature shall be resolved in accordance with the Constitution and Rules of the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA).
- **1.2.** Technical questions will be resolved according to the Constitution and Rules of the FITA.
- **1.3.** Only archers who comply with the OCA Constitution and Rules and the FITA Rules are entitled to take part in the Asian Games archery competitions.

2. Participants

Each National Olympic Committee (NOC) of the OCA member countries may enter up to four female and four male competitors and four team officials. But the total number of officials must not exceed the number of the competitors of that team.

3. Entries

3.1. Closing Date for Entry Forms by Number (Preliminary)

Entry Forms by Number from all teams, forwarded through the respective NOCs, must be received by the Seoul Asian Games Organizing Committee (SAGOC) not later than 2400 hours (Korea Standard Time), June 28, 1986. Entries may be sent by telex, but must be subsequently confirmed in writing. Telex Number: K21988. The address of the SAGOC can be found on the Entry Form by Number. These entries must state the exact number of competitors taking part in the events for women and men, respectively.

3.2. Closing Date for Entry Forms by Name (Final)

Entry Forms by Name must be received by the SAGOC not later than 2400 hours (Korea Standard Time), August 28, 1986. No changes or additional entries will be accepted after this time.

4. Medical Control

4.1. Doping Control

Doping control tests will be carried out in accordance with the instructions laid down by the SAGOC and in conjunction with the Asian Archery Federation (AAF). The number of athletes to undergo a doping control shall be agreed upon by the AAF and the SAGOC.

4.2. Femininity Control

Femininity control tests shall be carried out prior to the start of the Games in accordance with the instructions laid dowin by the SAGOC and in conjunction with the AAF except for those competitors who have a valid certificate of femininity issued by the FITA.
