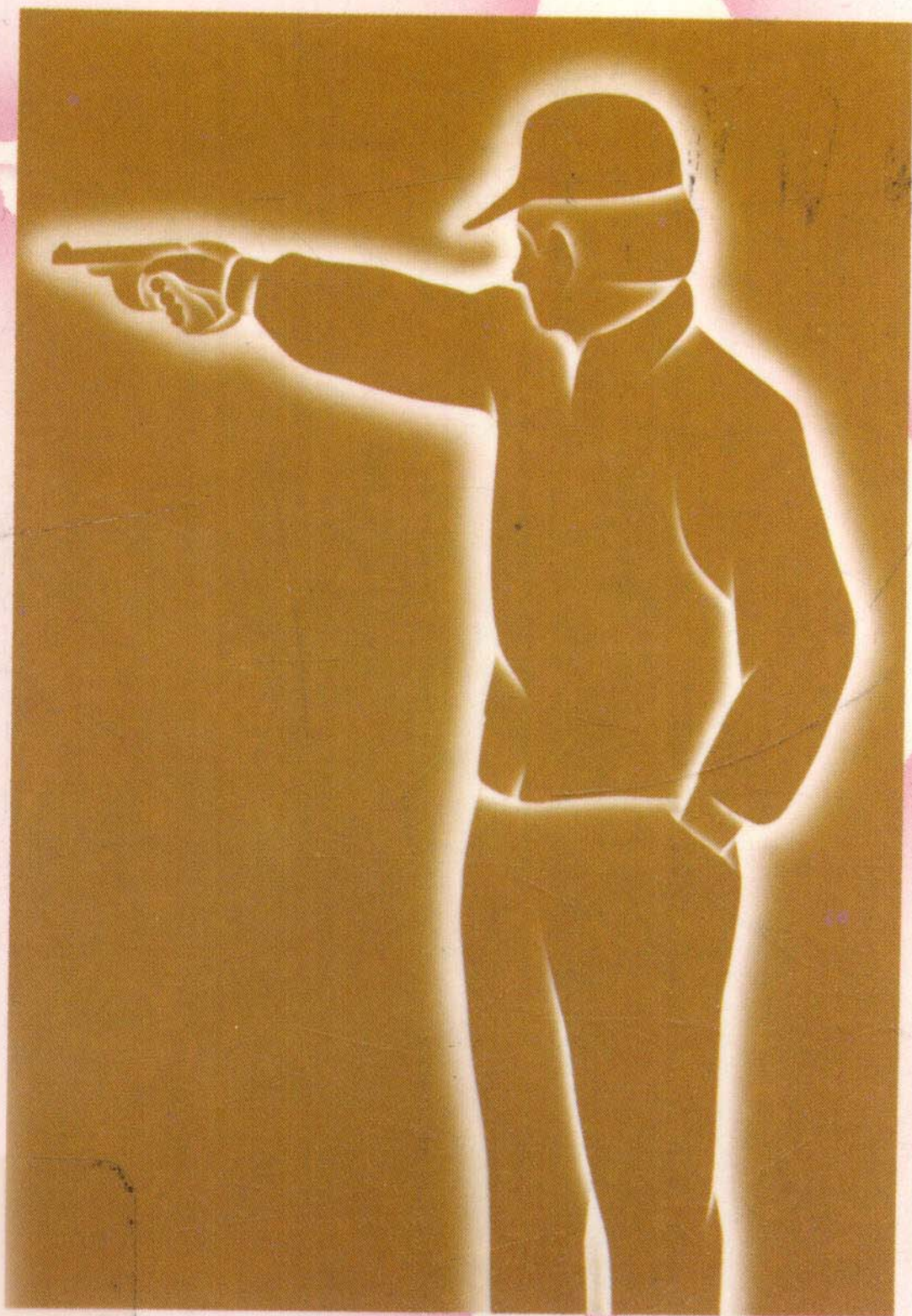

## **II. Competition Information**

### **1. Dates**

The shooting competitions for the 10th Asian Games will be held in Seoul from September 21 through September 28, 1986.

### **2. Venues**

#### **2.1. Competition Site**

The shooting competitions will take place on the Taenung International Shooting Range, located 18km from the Asian Games Village. The seating capacity at the Range will be approximately 3,000. Medical facilities, offices and other administration facilities will be located at the Range.

#### **2.2. Training Site**

The Taenung International Shooting Range will be open for training on September 10, 1986.

#### **2.3. Ranges**

The installations for the 10th Asian Games shooting competitions will include the following:

- 50m shooting range (rifle and pistol), 82 targets;
- 25m shooting range (rapid fire pistol), 12 units of 5 silhouette targets;
- Clay target range, 3 trenches and 3 skeet fields combined;
- 10m air gun range, enclosed with climate control, 100 positions.

### **3. Events**

The shooting competition will comprise the following events for men and women and will be fired in individual as well as team event.

### **3.1. Men's Events**

Small-bore free rifle, three positions:

120 shots (3 × 40 shots);

Distance: 50 meters.

Small-bore standard rifle, three positions:

60 shots (3 × 20 shots);

Distance: 50 meters.

Small-bore *free rifle, English match*:

60 shots;

Distance: 50 meters.

Air rifle:

60 shots;

Distance: 10 meters.

Free pistol:

60 shots;

Distance: 50 meters.

Rapid-fire pistol:

60 shots (2 × 30 shots);

Distance: 25 meters.

Center fire pistol:

60 shots (30 shots precision, 30 shots duel);

Distance: 25 meters.

Standard pistol:

60 shots;

Distance: 25 meters.

Air pistol:

60 shots;

Distance: 10 meters.



### **3.2. Women's Events**

Small-bore standard rifle, three positions:

60 shots ( $3 \times 20$  shots);

Distance: 50 meters.

Air rifle:

40 shots;

Distance: 10 meters.

Sport pistol:

60 shots (30 shots precision, 30 shots duel);

Distance: 25 meters.

Air pistol:

40 shots;

Distance: 10 meters.

### **3.3. Open Events**

Clay target shooting, trap

200 targets ( $2 \times 75$  and  $1 \times 50$ )

Clay target shooting, skeet

200 targets ( $2 \times 75$  and  $1 \times 50$ )

The first 150 birds will be counted towards team event.

## 5. Equipment

**5.1.** Equipment and installations will comply with the UIT Regulations and Rules. Targets at the competition and training sites will be supplied by Green Hill Foundation (KOR).

## 5.2. Firearms and Ammunition

**5.2.1.** Import and export of target, firearms and ammunition for use in the Asian Games will be guaranteed. Firearms and ammunition will have to be deposited at the shooting range armoury (Taenung International Shooting Range armoury).

**5.2.2.** Competitors must bring their own arms and ammunition from their respective countries.

**5.2.3.** Firearms and ammunition must be clearly identified to facilitate customs clearance.

**5.2.4.** All firearms and ammunition brought into Korea, for use during the shooting events of the 10th Asian Games, must be taken out of Korea by the date when each delegation or individual leaves Korea.
