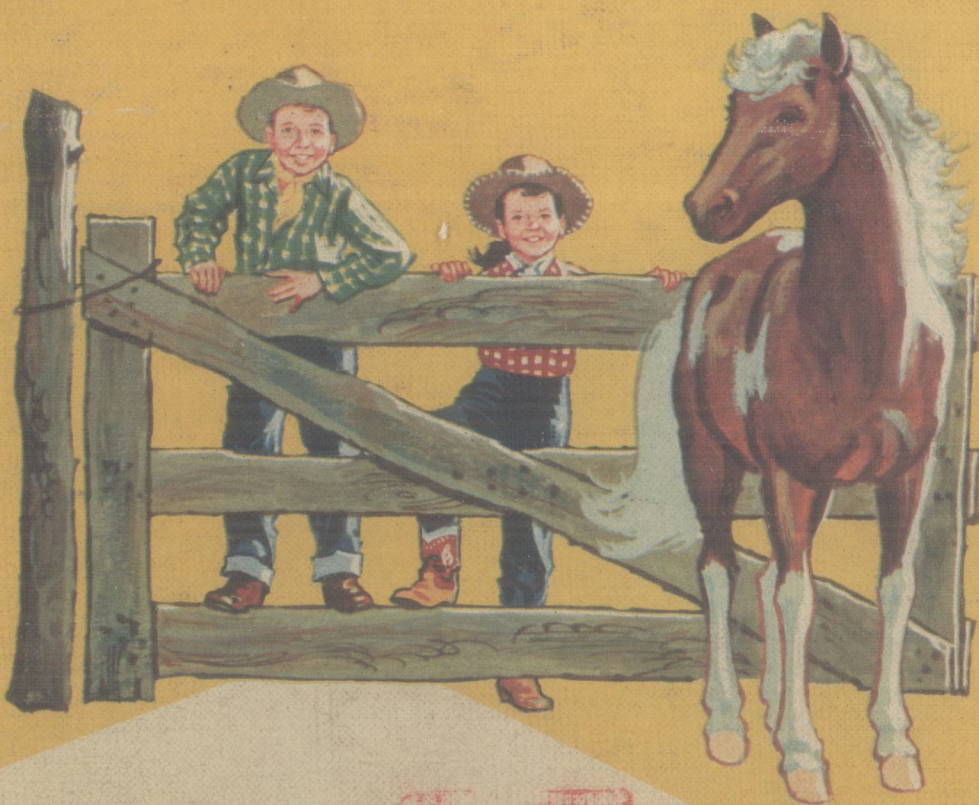

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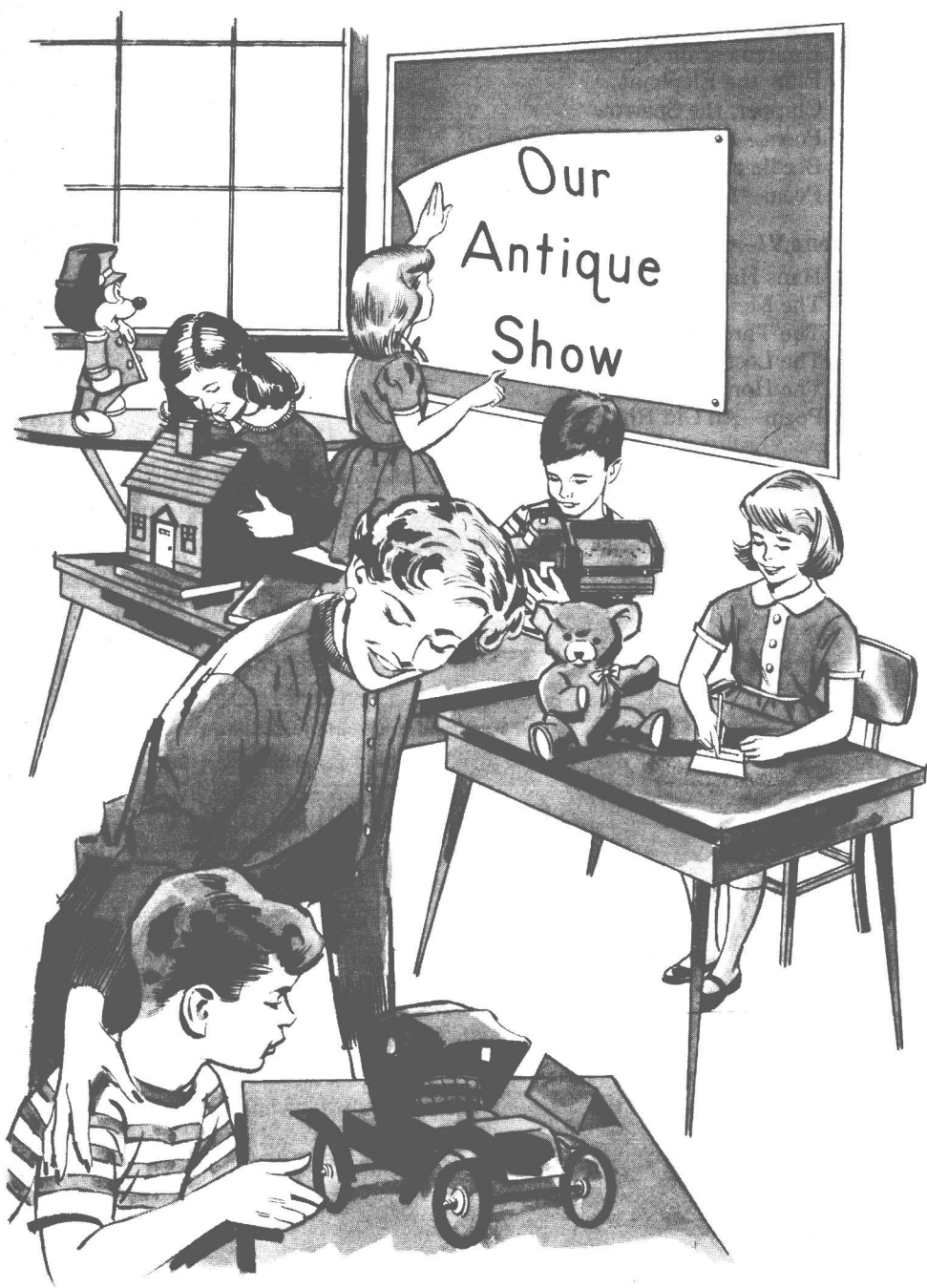

The big engine pulled the long train down the track.

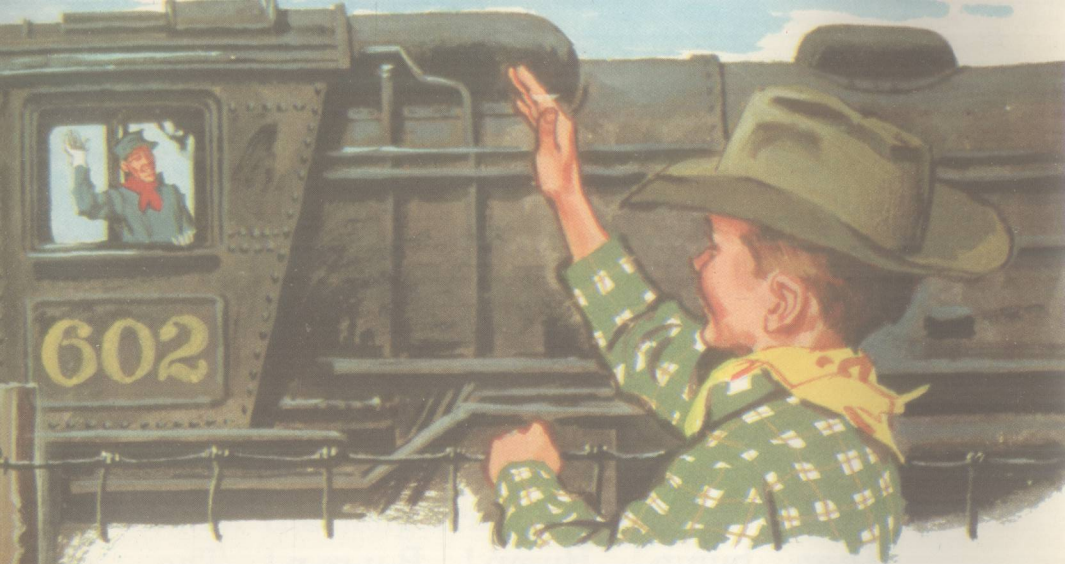
Then, bump! Bump! B-u-m-p! The old black engine stopped. All the cars in the long train stopped too.
