Introduction

The University is a rich resource centre with a strong research culture that actively encourages research on all fronts. Besides fostering inter-faculty co-operation in multi-disciplinary research, the University aims to promote closer ties and more collaboration with industry through technology transfer activities.

It is the intention of the University to achieve excellence in all faculties and disciplines. The research infrastructure is particularly conducive to building up a significant pool of R & D manpower in important areas, in line with the national emphasis on the development of a high technology and knowledge-intensive economy. With a resource pool that includes 1,600 academic staff, 2,400 research students and several hundred research scientists, assistants and technicians, the University is well-placed to play a pivotal role in the promotion of R & D for the country's advancement.

More than two-thirds of the University's 1,600 academic staff are PhD holders. It is hoped that this Directory will help staff to identify common areas of research interests so that expertise in different disciplines may be pooled for multi-disciplinary research activities. In the process, funds, facilities and time will be more likely to be put to optimum use.

This Directory also aims to serve as a means of generating increased industry awareness of the University's resources and research skills and expertise. The heightened interest and research effort thus generated may be harnessed to providing cost-effective solutions to technology-related problems. Commercialisation of university technology is actively promoted as it contributes to industry's technology upgrading and productivity. This publication should also prove useful to government ministries and other research bodies.
