HOW TO USE THE INDEX

THE INDEX is broken down into 14 sub-indexes by machine type and contains one section on General Articles.

We suggest that users approach THE INDEX by first locating topics of interest in the applicable machine-type sub-index and then cross check the general index to find additional material of interest indexed there.

At the end of the Index is a listing of magazines indexed, they are listed by their abbreviated names. The full name of the magazine, its address and other information concerning the publisher is given in each listing. These listings can serve as a source of copies for the individual publications. In addition, University Microfilms has agreements with several publishers to provide a reprint service upon request. Local libraries, local computer clubs and individual club members are good sources for locating back issues of desired magazines and articles.
