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The format of the abstract may have changed over the years but its importance as an authoritative source of government statistics has not. It remains an essential work of reference.

There have been many changes of definition over the last 100 years which makes comparisons with the 1980s difficult. One of the most important definitional changes that needs to be borne in mind is that in 1886 the whole of Ireland was part of the United Kingdom and included in its statistics. This makes a considerable difference to the figures for 1886 because although the population of Ireland is very similar now to what it was 100 years ago the population of the rest of the United Kingdom was considerably smaller then.

It is of course also difficult to compare prices over such a long period when spending patterns and the availability of goods changed so much but as a general guide, it is reckoned that in 1986 one would need more than £32 to buy what could be bought for £1 in 1886.
