Introduction

Two of the most important factors to students deciding where to apply to college are programs of study and college location. The *Index of Majors* is designed to help students find out which colleges offer the particular fields of study that interest them and are in the location they prefer. In addition, the *Index* includes lists of colleges that have religious affiliations or that offer special academic programs or special admissions procedures. Now in its eighth edition, the *Index* is based on all new data collected from colleges during the 1984-85 academic year.

Colleges eligible for listing

More than 2,800 colleges are included in the *Index of Majors*, 1985-86. These are all the institutions that responded to an invitation to be included in the twenty-third edition of *The College Handbook* by completing the College Board's Annual Survey of Colleges, 1985-86, as well as the graduate institutions that responded to the Annual Survey. The information supplied by colleges for the *Handbook* has been reorganized here to make it easier to find the names of colleges that offer the majors and special features that interest them.

To be included in the Handbook and Index, an institution must meet the criteria for inclusion in the Higher Education General Information Survey (HEGIS) by the U.S. Office of Education Division of Eligibility and Agency Evaluation. This includes colleges accredited by a nationally recognized accrediting agency or approved by a state department of education or a state university; colleges that have attained preaccredited status with a nationally recognized accrediting agency; and public and nonprofit colleges whose credits have been accepted as if coming from an accredited institution by at least three accredited institutions. The other criterion for inclusion in the Handbook is that the college offer some undergraduate programs; however, institutions offering graduate-level curriculums only are included in the Index. Six institutions in foreign countries are included here on the basis of their membership in the College Board. To find out if a particular college or graduate institution that interests you is listed in the Index, see "Colleges included in this book."

Major fields of study

There are 514 major fields of study listed in the *Index*. Each major field of study is listed alphabetically and the colleges

and graduate schools that say they offer a major in that field are listed state by state. Some institutions listed here do not offer majors in the traditional sense, but do provide indepth specialization which approximates the course work usually required for a degree.

The list of curriculum fields used in the *Index* is based on the new HEGIS taxonomy of instructional programs used by the National Center for Education Statistics. Colleges were provided with the list of fields and asked to use it to report their majors, even though their own titles for some of the programs might not fit exactly the titles on the list. However, colleges could and often did add the names of other curriculums that they felt did not conform closely enough to any title on the list. These additional fields are *not* included in the *Index of Majors*, but can be found in *The College Handbook*.

Two types of associate majors are offered: (1) technologies and vocational specialties that are generally completed in two years of college study and are usually sufficient for entrance into an occupational field, and (2) college- or university-parallel programs, which are like the first two years of a four-year college curriculum. Students obtaining a degree in a nonvocational area often transfer to four-year colleges where they complete the requirements for a bachelor's degree in a specific major.

Bachelor's degree programs generally require four or more years of study. Graduate programs vary in length. The degree level offered in a specific major is indicated by the letter after each college's name:

Associate (A)

Bachelor's degree (B)

Master's degree (M)

Doctor's degree (D)

First professional degree (F)

Work beyond doctor's or first professional degrees (W)

Special academic programs

There are twelve special academic programs listed in this section: accelerated study, combined bachelor's/graduate degree, cooperative education, double major, external degree, honors program, independent study, internship, student-designed major, study abroad, teacher preparation, and 3-2 liberal arts and career combination. The programs are described at the beginning of each list. For each program, there is a state-by-state listing of colleges that say they offer that option. Institutions that offer these programs through cross-registration are generally not listed. However, colleges that offer 3-2 liberal arts and career combinations through joint programs with other institutions are included here. For specific information about academic programs offered through cross-registration, and for information about other

special programs not listed in the *Index*, readers should consult *The College Handbook*.

Special admissions procedures

Colleges that say they subscribe to the Candidates Reply Date Agreement (CRDA) and the Early Decision Plan (EDP), two special admissions programs, are listed in this section. The purpose of both agreements is to protect the interests of students applying to colleges: in the first instance by allowing the applicant for admission to hear from all the colleges to which he or she has applied before making a final decision, and in the second instance by allowing students to hear from the colleges of their choice as early as possible in their senior year, thus reducing anxiety and unnecessary multiple applications. The programs are defined at the beginning of each list.

Colleges that have religious affiliations

This section lists 48 religious denominations and organizations and the colleges, state by state, that reported they were affiliated with each. The list of religious groups is based on the survey list used by the National Center for Education Statistics. Colleges were supplied with this list and asked to report any affiliation, whether formal or informal. Those colleges that said they were affiliated with religious groups not included on this list are reported under the heading "Other religious affiliations." The name of the specific affiliation for each of these colleges can be found in *The College Handbook* in the individual college description.

Colleges included in this book

This section tells you which colleges appear in the *Index* of Majors, 1985-86. Institutions are listed by state and by whether they characterize themselves as two-year, two-year upper-division, three-year, four-year, five-year, or graduate institutions. Generally, two-year colleges offer associate degrees only. In a few cases — usually at branch campuses of university systems — a junior or community college also awards a bachelor's degree. These colleges are indicated by a superscript after the college name. Upper-division institutions and colleges offering three or more years of study usually grant bachelor's degrees. Many of these colleges also offer degrees at the graduate and associate levels. For those colleges that offer associate as well as bachelor's degrees, a

superscript^a appears after the college's name. An address to which students can write for additional information is also included for each college.

Indexes

There are two indexes to the major fields of study listed in the *Index*. In "Major fields of study by discipline," subjects are grouped into general categories corresponding to the HEGIS taxonomy. Students who know the broad discipline in which they are interested but who seek additional information about what specific majors are offered within that discipline should look here. The second index lists all major fields of study in alphabetic sequence.
