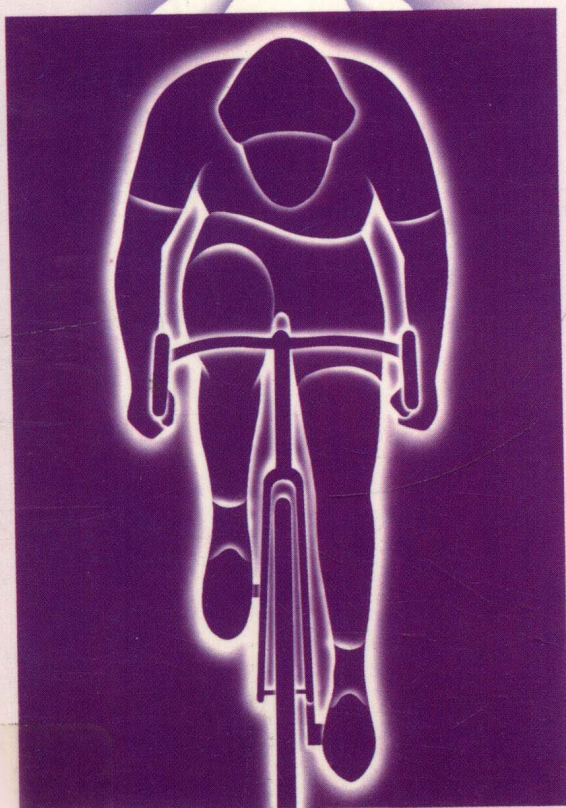

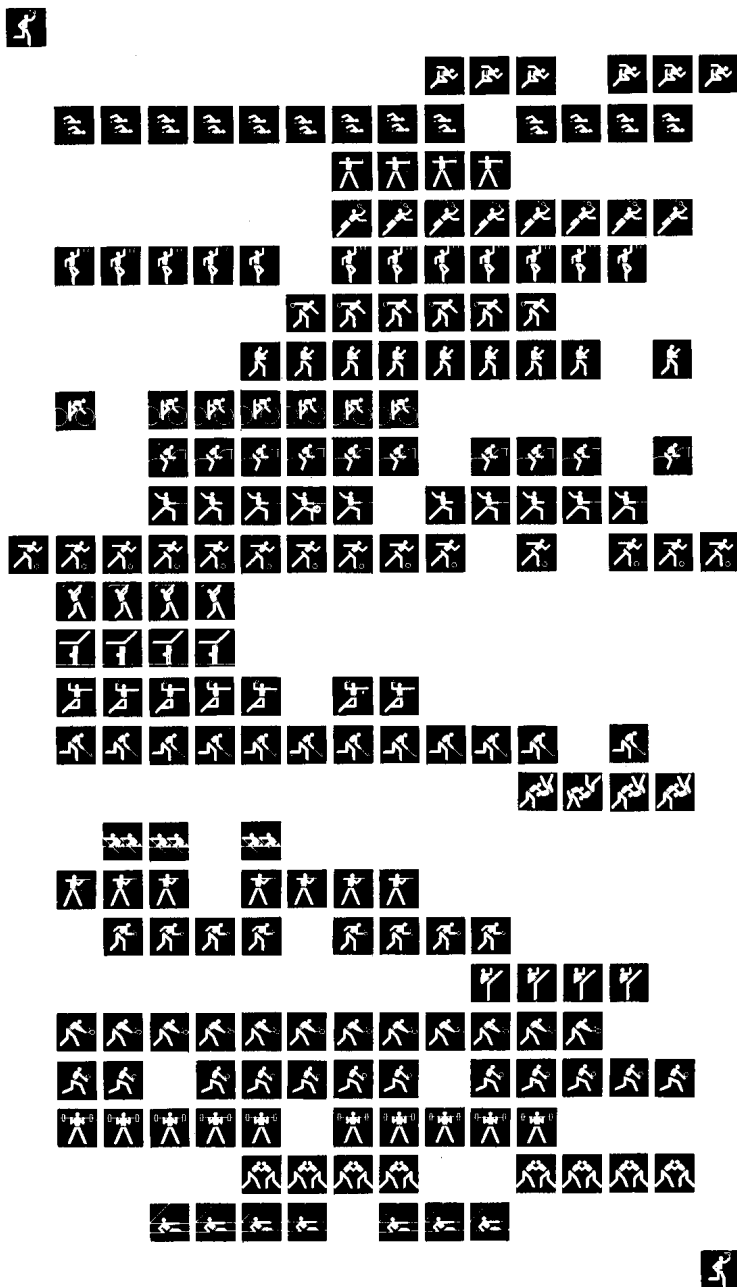

II. Competition Information

1. Dates

The 10th Asian Games cycling competitions will be held from September 21 through September 28, 1986.

2. Venues

2.1. Competition Sites

2.1.1. Track Events

The track events will be conducted at the Olympic Velodrome located at the Olympic Park approximately 4km from the Asian Games Village.

Features of Track:

- Length: 333.33 m
- Width: 7 m
- Seating capacity: approximately 6,000 seats
- Material: wood
- Gradient: 10°-38°

2.1.2. Road Events

The cycling circuit for individual road race for men and women is located at the Seoul Grand Park on the south of Seoul.

The route for team time trial is a 25km segment of the Tongil Ro on the northwest of Seoul. The circuit of 50km is covered twice by each team.

2.2. Training Sites

2.2.1. Track

The training site for track events will be the Olympic Velodrome. A training schedule will be drawn up according to the number of teams taking part in the competition.

2.2.2. Road

The competition sites for road races will be available to all cyclists for road training purposes. Transportation to this course will be provided by the Seoul Asian Games Organizing Committee (SAGOC).

3. Events

The cycling competitions will consist of the following events:

3.1. Track

Individual Events:

- 1km time trial, men
- Sprint, men (3 laps of the track)
- Sprint, women (3 laps of the track)
- 4km pursuit, men
- 30km points race, men

Team Events:

- 4,000m pursuit, men

3.2. Road

Individual Events:

- Road race, men(circuit approximately 180km)
- Road race, women(circuit approximately 64km)

Team Events:

- 100km time trial, men

5. Equipment

5.1. Repair Workshop

A repair workshop will be located at the Olympic Velodrome. In addition, spare bicycles for road events will be supplied.

5.2. Motorcycles

Five motorcycles will be available to teams for training purposes at the Olympic Velodrome.

III. General Rules and Regulations

1. Rules

The cycling competitions will be conducted in accordance with the Rules of the International Amateur Cycling Federation(FIAC). In case of disagreement in the interpretation of the Rules, the French text shall prevail. Any unforeseen incidents not covered by the Rules shall be dealt with as follows:

- 1.1.** Cases of a general nature shall be resolved in accordance with the Constitution and Rules of the Olympic Council of Asia(OCA).
- 1.2.** Technical questions shall be resolved according to the FIAC Rules.
- 1.3.** Only athletes who comply with the OCA Constitution and Rules and the FIAC Rules are entitled to take part in the cycling competitions.

2. Participants

Each National Olympic Committee(NOC) of the OCA member countries may enter a maximum of twenty(20) competitors: fifteen(15) competitors for men's races and five(5) competitors for women's races. Only competitors who reach the age of seventeen(17) by December 31, 1986, inclusive may compete. All participants must hold the nationality of the country of their NOC. In case of objections, the NOC concerned must provide proof of nationality. In addition, every cyclist must have a FIAC international license, valid for 1986 and issued by the FIAC or his national federation affiliated to the FIAC.

2.1. Track Events

- 1km time trial,
one (1) entered, one (1) to ride
- Sprint,
two (2) entered, two (2) to ride
- 4km individual pursuit,
two (2) entered, two (2) to ride
- 4,000m team pursuit,
four (4) entered, four (4) to ride
- 30km points race,
two (2) entered, two (2) to ride

2.2. Road Events

- 100km team time trial, men,
four (4) entered, four (4) to ride
- Individual road race, men,
four (4) entered, four (4) to ride
- Individual road race, women,
three (3) entered, three (3) to ride

2.3. All cyclists entered in the competitions may act as substitutes in all other races for which they have not specifically been entered.

2.4. Participating Countries

All countries participating in the 10th Asian Games cycling events must have been affiliated to the FIAC.
