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Biography Almanac

Introduction

The second volume of *Biography Almanac* contains three indexes of interest to the researcher and the trivia buff.

There are two chronological indexes: one by year; the other by date. The index by year lists, in alphabetical order, first everyone in *Biography Almanac* who was born on a specific year, month, and day, then everyone in the book who died on that date. For instance, both John Adams and Thomas Jefferson died in 1826 and both died on July 4.

The second chronological index lists, in alphabetical order, all *Biography Almanac* entrants who were born or died in a specific month on a specific day. The year of birth or death appears after the entrant's name in chronological order. For example, this index lists 55 people who were born on July 4 and 32 people who died on July 4.

The third index is the geographic index, enabling the user to find everyone who was born or who died in a specific location. The index is divided into three general sections: the United States, Canada, and Foreign. The United States is further broken down by state and then by city within the state; Canada is broken down by province and city; and Foreign is in alphabetical order by country. Below each city are the names of those people appearing in *Biography Almanac* who were either born or who died in that location, followed by the birth or death date. Under New York, New York, for example, Norman Rockwell is listed with his birthdate, Feb. 3, 1894, and

Nelson Rockefeller is listed with his deathdate, Jan. 26, 1979. Rockwell also appears under Stockbridge, Massachusetts, with his deathdate and Rockefeller appears under Bar Harbor, Maine, with his birthdate.
