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序 Preface

看了《感受南半球》样稿，我有一种身临其境的感觉，在镜头的指引下，我不仅了解了澳大利亚及新西兰这两个南半球主要国度的城市风光，甚至还感受到了访问者融入异国风情中的那种兴奋、快乐和满足。我想这就是摄影艺术的魅力。

拿到样稿时我很惊讶，因为沈珂只用了短短十余天的时间，就拍成了这本内容详实、影像生动的大型国外城市风光和人文风情画册。但当我得知沈珂在出访期间，除了公务考察外，经常睡眠很少，甚至几个晚上彻夜未眠，全身心地投入到创作采风之中的时候，我的好奇也就有了答案。从一张张摄取的镜头和加注的文字来看，没有事先充分的准备，没有对拍摄对象充分的了解，没有对创作的深入思考，没有扎实的基本功，仅凭走马观花就想手到擒来，那是不可能的。

初识沈珂还是多年前在广东高明举办的一次摄影大奖赛上。当时国内“非典”危机刚刚解除，沉寂了一段时间的摄影创作活动首先在广东高明开始，由中国摄影在线举办了规模较大的两个摄影比赛——“佳能杯”摄影赛和“德国禄来杯”摄影赛。当时沈珂作为浙江的参赛者，分别获得了两个比赛的两个银奖，给人留下了深刻的印象。作为一名基层海关的领号，对摄影艺术有如此执着的追求和可喜的成就，不仅让人感动，也令人敬佩，这也是让我理解了为什么一名基层海关的领导会同时成为浙江省摄影家协会副秘书长的原因。应该说，沈珂虽然从8岁开始就把玩相机，对摄影艺术有执着的追求，但毕竟可供他创作的时间是非常有限的。因此，每当进入创作状态，他总是珍惜分分秒秒，全身心地投入其中，风餐露宿，不辞辛苦。这才有了他今天的成就。我在阅读沈珂这部作品的时候又一次深深地感到，敬业是任何事业取得成功的最重要的主观条件。

精彩来自于精神，艺无止境，来日方长。我有理由相信，沈珂会有更勤的耕耘，更大的收获！

Having read the ready-to-be printed album of photographs Experiencing the Northern Hemisphere, I felt I was taking a vicarious trip with Mr. Shen Ke. Through his lens, I not only saw the highlights of the cities in the two countries in the Southern Hemisphere, Australia and New Zealand, but also felt the excitement, exhilaration and gratification of the visitor that came through his emersion in the ambience of exotic culture.

I was surprised when I looked at the album because it took Mr. Shen only a little more than ten days to complete this album that contains a large number of vivid photos focusing on the urban highlights and cultural features. When I learned that in addition to his official duties on this business tour, he took this opportunity to make this collection, and worked selflessly at the sacrifice of his rest, sleeping only a few hours a day and sometimes working throughout the night, my bewilderment vanished. Judging from each of these photographs and captions, we can see it is impossible to produce such fine pieces of art work without prior preparation, good understanding of the objects covered, profound thought for creation and a solid foundation of the basic knowledge and skills. One can never attain such achievements just by roaming around and pressing the camera button.

I first got to know Mr. Shen Ke at a photographing contest in Gaoming, Guangdong several years ago, when the epidemic of SARS was just over and the photographing activities was restarted in Gaoming, where two photographing contests were held, the Cannon Cup and the German Rollei Cup. I was deeply impressed that Mr. Shen as a contestant from Zhejiang won two silver medals from the contests. It is not only touching but also commendable that Mr. Shen as a local customs leader has been so dedicated to photographing and made such remarkable achievements. This explains why he is concurrently made the vice secretary-general of the Zhejiang Association of Photographers. Although he began to play with a camera at the age of six, and has since had an ardent love for photography, now he has very limited time for his artistic creation. Therefore, whenever a chance presents itself for his creative work, he readily enters into the mood and work whole-heartedly, making the best of every minute in spite of the difficulties he may have to face in life and work. That is why he has achieved so much. Reading this album, once again I feel deeply that dedication is the single most important factor in one's career.

In this world, which is boundless in space and ever-changing in form, art knows no bonds and excellence comes from one's enterprising spirit. I have every reason to believe that Mr. Shen Ke will make greater achievements by dint of his diligence in the long years to come.

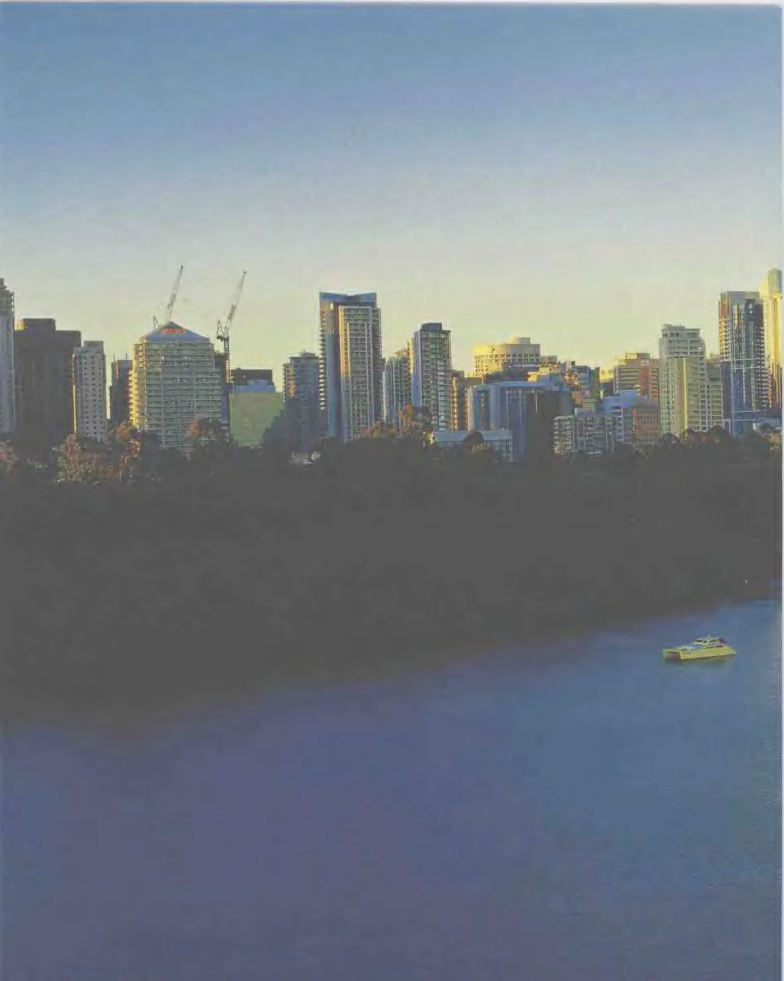

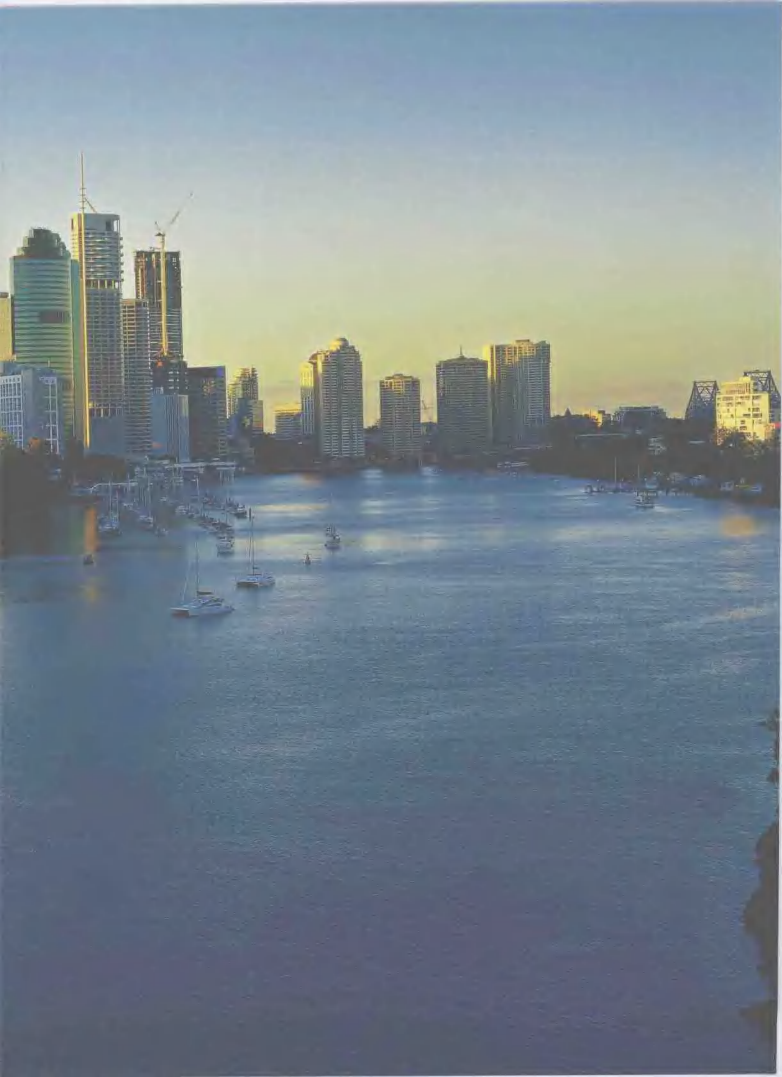

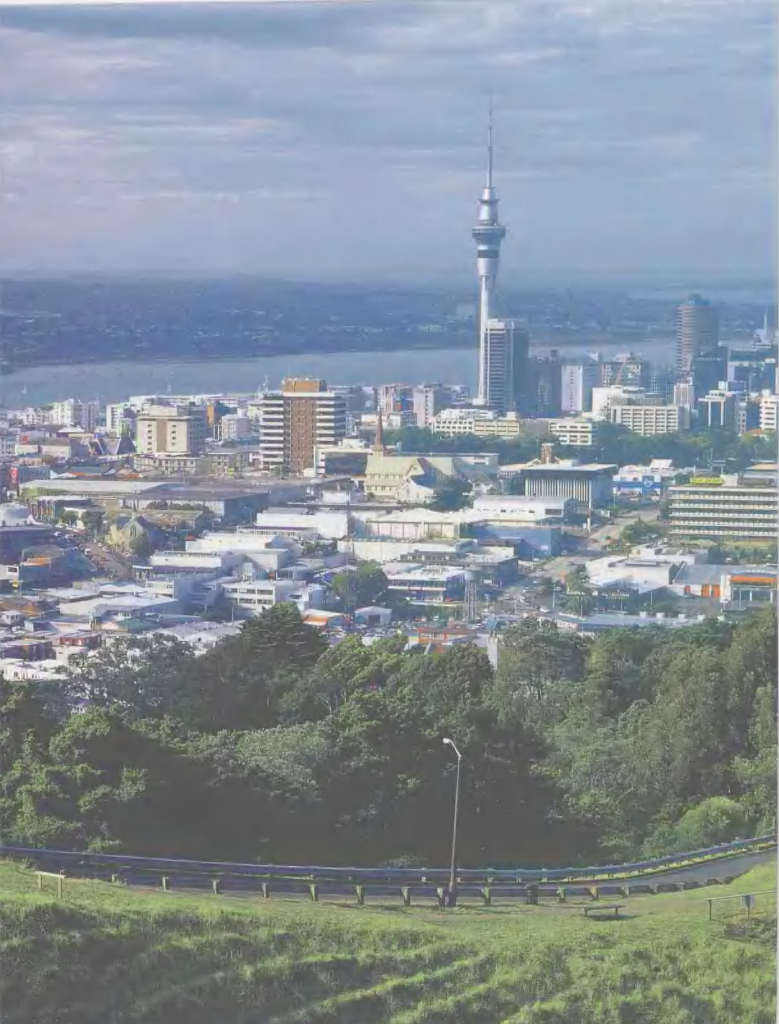
