The Recycling of Waste

With fifteen years Britain and other nations should be well on with the building of huge industrial complexes for the recycling of waste. The word rubbish could lose its meaning for everything which goes into the dumps would be made into something useful. Even the most dangerous and unpleasant wastes would provide energy if nothing else.

The latest project is to take a city of around half a million inhabitants to discover exactly what raw materials go into it and what go out. The aim is to find out how much of these raw materials could be provided if a plant for recycling waste is built just outside the city. This plant would recycle not only metal such as steel, lead and copper, but also paper and rubber as well.

Another new project is being set up to discover the best ways of sorting and separating the rubbish. When this project is complete, the rubbish will be processed like this; First, it will pass through sharp metal bars that will tear open the plastic bags in which rubbish is usually packed; then it will pass through a powerful fan to separate the lightest elements from the heavy solids; after that founders and rollers will break up everything that can be broken. Finally, the rubbish will pass under magnets, which will remove the bits of iron and steel; the rubber and plastic will then be sorted out in the final stage.

The first full-scale giant recycling plants are perhaps fifteen years away.Indeed, with the growing cost of transporting rubbish to more distant dumps, some big cities will be forced to build their own recycling plants before long.

The Importance of Water

Some doctors suggest that you should drink a glass of water each morning. You should drink this water first thing before doing anything else. The temperature of the water should be similar to body temperature; not hot, not cold. Why should you drink this water? Water helps your body in many ways. It helps to clean out your kidneys (肾). It prepares your stomach for digestion. Water



can also help your intestines (肠) work better. After drinking water, the intestines can more easily take out nutrients from our food. And water helps us to go to the bathroom more easily.

Scientists suggest that people take in 1 600 milliliters of water each day. But don't drink all of that water in one sitting. If you do, your kidneys will have to work much harder to eliminate it. It's better to drink some in the morning and some in the afternoon. Some people think it's better to drink between meals and not during meals. They think water dilutes the juices produced in our stomachs. This can interfere with normal digestion.

Are you drinking enough water every day? Check the colour of your urine (尿). If it is light yellow, you are probably drinking enough. If your urine is very dark yellow, you probably need to drink more water. A little more water each day could make you much healthier!

Disney opens its first theme park in China

Disney officially opened its newest theme park in Hong Kong on Monday, September

12, 2005, its first step into the lucrative China market . Some 2 500 dignitaries and guests were on hand, including Chinese Vice President Zeng Qinghong, Hong Kong leader DonaldTsang, Walt Disney Company CEO Michael Eisner and company president Robert Iger.

Disney characters and dragon dance performance are seen in front of the Sleeping Beauty Castle during the opening ceremony of Hong Kong Disneyland .The ceremony of opening the US \$3.5-billion park kicked off with a traditional Chinese lion dance in the forecourt of Sleeping Beauty Castle.



The Hong Kong government, which chipped in 1.8 billion Hong Kong dollars of the construction cost and owns a half-share of equity (资产净值) in the project, is hoping the park will spur local tourism and bring in more than 100 billion dollars over the next 40 years.

The attraction and its two resort hotels are surrounded by mountains on lush Lantau Island, just 30 minutes away by subway from central Hong Kong. It looks much like the first Disneyland in California, with a Space Mountain thrill ride, a classic Cinderella Carousel and a pink Sleeping Beauty Castle—which Disney predicts will be one of the most photographed buildings in Asia.

Hong Kong's government says the attraction will help turn this global financial capital into Asia's best family holiday spot.

Disney hopes the park—the 11st in its global empire—will be a magnet for increasingly wealthy Chinese tourists, who have a reputation for being big-spenders.

一、阅读理解题的特点

从近几年高考试题来看,阅读理解题考查的核心并不是衡量考生的英语语言知识,而是考查学生对文章的篇章结构和深层信息的处理能力。因而,考生应在掌握大量的词汇及语言基础知识的前提下,努力提高自己的语言运用能力。综观历年高考考题,其难度一般由三个因素来决定,即文章的选材、设题及阅读量。

二、阅读理解题的命题趋向

1. 阅读材料更趋向于真实性、实用性和教育性

关注实际生活的选材特点在近年的高考阅读理解试题中已经呈现出明显的增强趋势。这种趋势与当时基础教育的改革要求是一致的。中学生语言学习的根本目的是学会求知,学会做事,学会合作,学会做人。真实性和实用性选材是适应基础教育英语课程的改革目标,选材的教育性是基于考生不仅要懂得文章的意思,还要进行思考而设立的。

2. 由猜测词义到对整个句子意义的理解将是一个新的命题热点

词义猜测题一般是利用上下文,通过对应结构或平行结构中同义词或反义词来进行判断生词的意义。

3. 问题的创设将会更加灵活多样、尤以整体理解和推理为主

高考阅读理解设立的问题大多数不能按字面意思随手可得,需要阅读后归纳 并概括中心,推测作者写作意图,挖掘深层含义。有些题目还要加以逻辑推理才 可能选择出正确的答案。

4. 所选材料的结构复杂化,生疏但能读懂的短语和表达方式将达到一定的数量

在近来高考阅读理解中多次出现考生感到陌生的短语。这些短语的出现在一定程度上加大了难度,但是符合《考试说明》的要求,也体现了语言学习的适用性和灵活性。

Television Terms

Do you ever wonder where television words come from? Many TV terms come from the combination of two words. Even the word television is made up of two words. These words are Greek and Latin words meaning "far" and "to see".



One kind of TV program is a soap opera. The first soap operas were stories on the radio. These stories are serials. They are continuous and can go on for many years. Soap companies first advertised their products during these shows on TV. The soap companies knew lots of wives and mothers watched these shows. And in fact, for some of the programs all of the commercials during the shows were for different kinds of soap. People then started calling these shows "soap operas".


Serious TV programs are called dramas. Funny ones are called comedies. Some programs are both funny and serious. This kind of show is called a "Dramedy", the combination of "drama" and "comedy". In a similar way, sitcom is the combination of "situation" and "comedy".

Infomercials are another kind of interesting program on TV. An infomercial is a very long commercial. One can last three or four hours. The word infomercial is the combination of "information" and "commercial". Infomercials began in the 1980s. Now you can watch hours and hours of infomercials for all kinds of products, especially on cable television. Just be careful, you don't turn into a couch potato!
