









### Foreword

The earth is the homeland of humanity as well as the habitat for a multitude of animal creatures. Along with the intensification of human activities, the number of endangered species is increasing day by day, and their habitats are suffering from destruction or vanishing; Every day there are animal species obliterated from the earth forever!

China is a great country endowed with abundant biological diversity. Since its policy of reformation and opening - up, its development has been remarkably fast, thus inevitably constituted a menace to the survival of wild animals. The contradiction between human activities on the one hand and the conservation of wildlife on the other hand has been particularly striking in River Chang Jiang (The Yangtze). This book highlights the introduction to the Baiji Dolphin, the Chinese Sturgeon, the Chinese Alligator, the David's Deer and the Yangtze River Finless Porpoise, concentrating the introduction of these five precious and rare animals to one single popular science reading material for the first time. Among them, the first four have been designated National Class - 1 protected animals, while the Yangtze Finless Porpoise belongs to National Class - 2 protected amimal. The Baiji Dolphin has been exposed to the condition of extreme endangerment, and its salvation becomes very difficult; induced propagation has been successful in the Chinese Sturgeon and the Chinese Alligator, but still there is a remarkably long way to go for the preservation of their species; the David's Deer was recovered
