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# 前言

《英语口语实训教程》是按照教育部高等教育司颁布的《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求》编写而成,是粤教高〔2007〕7号关于 2006年广东省高等学校英语教改与实践培育项目文件公布的《就业导向的高职英语测试与教学的整合性改革》课题中的一个子项目。该套教材本着厚基础、重能力、以就业为导向的总体思路,根据高职毕业生到一线从事技术工作的实际需求,注重优化整合课程内容,突出高职特色,做到实用性强。

### 主要特色

- 1. 以培养能力为主。高职的重要特色是强化人才的能力培养。为突出能力培养,本教材围绕英语应用能力这条主线来设计学生的知识、能力、素质结构。
- 2. 突出口语训练的实战性。重视语言技能的教学和交际能力的培养,口语的训练量较大,内容由浅入深、先简后繁、循序渐进。
- 3. 参考价值大。所选的素材力求语言流畅、真实地道、正确规范,内容贴近学生现实生活,具有趣味性和时代气息,容易唤起学生的学习兴趣,使其充分融入学习过程,深化学习效果。考虑到学生的实际需要,每个单元还设一个交际功能板块,集中列出表达某种交际功能的日常口语所用句型,并据此提供三个样板会话,具有极强的参考价值。
- 4. 提供样板对话的同时,配以相应练习,有针对性地设置了各种情景,要求学生结合自身实际情况,利用所学内容进行口语训练,使学生在充分输入和输出的过程中学到地道规范的语言,能够得体地进行口语活动。

### 本套教材的基本框架

《高职高专英语口语实训教程》分上、下两册,又独立成书。每册共编有 12 个单元,一个单元针对一个话题。上册内容为日常和涉外业务活动中进行 信息交流的实际场景,如介绍、招呼、问候、告别、问路、电话交谈、订房、 订票、接待、住宿等,体现就业需求。通过教学,帮助学生夯实基础并具备一定的英语口语与会话应变能力,能在涉外场合进行一般性的交流。下册以市场和社会需求下的高职人才培养模式为出发点,编写了求职面试、预约会见、日程安排、产品广告、市场推销、看样订货、价格支付、质量投诉、售后服务等具体商务活动场景,并渗透到我院各专业的特点和就业实际中去。

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### 使用说明



## Introducing Oneself

# Asking Someone to Introduce

## Responses

Thank you!

Would you love to introduce me to him?

Zhang Jie: Yes, I'll be glad to. Look! He's over there.

Li Ming: I know you very well by reputation, Mr. Bai. I like your writings

very much.

Bai Yang: I'm glad to hear that.
