





A World of Games




Do you like to play games? Kids and **adults** around the world play all different kinds of games. They like to **compete** to see who will win.

Many games are popular because people can play them using **simple** things, such as chalk and stones. The games can be played on a driveway, a sidewalk, sand, or a carved piece of wood.




Playing Games in Africa

Games have been a part of African culture, or way of life, for a long time. Many games that we play today, such as tic-tac-toe, may have come from Africa. The African game of mancala may be one of the oldest games in the world!



People in West Africa play a game called yoté. Yoté is a little like checkers. Let's learn how to play yoté.

> ▼ These children live in West Africa. They are playing different types of mancala games.



What Is Yoté?

In both yoté and checkers, each player uses **pieces** to jump the other player's pieces. Games like checkers and yoté help players practice a strategy. Using a strategy helps each player decide what moves to make to win the game.

Two people can play yoté. Each player has 12 pieces. To win, a player has to capture the opponent's pieces.

▼ The beach is a good place for a yoté **board**.



Setting Up Yoté

To set up an outdoor game of yoté, dig a board in the ground or sand. Make five rows with six holes in each row. You can also play yoté on a sidewalk. Draw the board using chalk.

The playing pieces can be rocks, shells, coins, or even jellybeans. Just be sure that each player has different colored playing pieces. 阅读参考词汇

How to Play Yoté

Number of Players: 2

Goal of the Game:


To capture all of the other player's pieces.

How to Play:

- 1. Each player begins with 12 playing pieces.
- 2. The first player puts one piece in any hole on the board.
- 3. Then the next player puts one piece in any hole on the board.
- 4. Now it's the first player's turn again. This player can put another piece in a hole, or move his or her first piece. These are the rules for moving the playing pieces:
 - Pieces can only be moved one space at a time.
 - Pieces can only be moved up, down, right, or left. There are no diagonal moves.
 - Only one piece at a time can go into an empty hole.



5. The players take turns putting more pieces on the board or moving pieces that are already in the holes.



▲ The players move their pieces one space at a time.

Jumping to Win

The players can capture each other's pieces by jumping over them. Jumps can only be up, down, left, or right. There are no diagonal jumps. After a jump, the player gets to take that piece from the board. Then the jumper takes another of the opponent's pieces from anywhere else on the board!

The game is over when there are no more moves left for the players to make. The player who has captured the most pieces wins the game.

▼ If you capture all of your opponent's pieces, how many pieces will you have?




Think First

Yoté is a game of strategy. To win, you must think carefully about your moves. As you move your pieces, think
