本套教材针对职业教育的特点共设 4 册,每册 8 个单元,授课时间可安排 180-220 学时。本套教材每个单元分为 Highlights (单元重点)、Listening and Speaking (听说)、Reading (阅读) 和 Trying Your Hand (语法写作) 四个部分,基本囊括了英语学习的各个方面,具有很强的实用性。

一、各部分主要内容

1. Highlights (单元重点)

本部分将单元重点——列出,使学生在学习之前能明确学习目标,把握学习方向,使学习更轻松、更容易。

2. Listening and Speaking (听说)

本部分设有 Imitate and Memorize (模仿和记忆)、Dialogue (对话)、Passage (篇章) 和 Manners Bar (礼仪吧)四个板块,兼具知识性、实用性和趣味性,寓教于乐。此外,第一册还专设有 Pronunciation (语音)专题,系统介绍了国际音标和连读、重读、语调等语音知识,不仅能帮助学生矫正发音,同时也有助于提高他们的听说能力。

3. Reading (阅读)

阅读部分第一册设有 Text A 和 Text B 两篇课文,从第二册开始还增设了 Text C 课文。Text A 和 Text B 课文涵盖有科普、人物、政治、商贸、文化、生活 等题材,Text C 则主要是应用文阅读。

为激发学生学习的积极性,本套教材在单元主课文 Text A 前设有 2 分钟演讲栏目,让学生通过积极参与和锻炼,更好地理解 Text A,同时提高口语水平。精心设计的课后练习,不仅涵盖高等学校英语应用能力考试的题型,而且增设了 Crossword 等趣味性较强的题目以提高学生的学习兴趣。

Text B 为辅助课文,可作为阅读理解材料使用,Text C 则选取了一些与我们生活和工作最相关的应用文,用于增强学生的英语应用能力,以达到学以致用的目的。

4. Trying Your Hand (语法写作)

为使学生不仅能看、能说,还能写,本部分对重要语法点进行了系统介绍,

通过由浅人深地详细讲解,教授学生如何用英文进行一般文体和应用文体的写作,为今后的运用打下基础。

二、本套教材的亮点

1. Text A 前的 Two-minute Presentation (两分钟演讲)

此项活动虽然只有两分钟,但却可以极大地弥补很多学生只会读写、不会听说的弱点,使 学生的口语水平有很大提高。

2. 听说部分的礼仪吧 (Manners Bar)

该板块考虑到学生的阅读理解能力有限,所以采用了汉语夹英语的教学方式,使学生易懂、爱看,在丰富知识的同时强化了学习效果。

3. 编写严谨, 难度适中

本套教材充分考虑了职业教育学生的学习水平和学习特点,科学地控制了教材的难度,适合作为高等职业学校、高等专科学校、成人高校、民办高校和应用型本科的教材,同时也是自学人员学习的首选用书。

另外,为使学生学习更方便,目标更明确,本套教材后附有高等学校英语应用能力考试大 纲、样题和词汇帮助学生学习。

网上赚钱

网上无本赚钱, Alladvangtage 是一个有代表性的先锋。1999 年 3 月 30 日, Alladvangtage 正式 开张,主要经营电子商务(EB: Electronic Business),但其夺人之处在于开创了"网上无本传销"的先例。只要您装上该公司提供的免费上网软件,该软件便会在您上网时自动运行,不断为您显示各种广告(advertisement),只要您不关闭它,每小时便可赚 0.5 美元,每月每个账户(account)最多可累计 40 小时。

发展至今,网上赚钱的形式已经多种多样了,比如"点击赚钱"、"邮件赚钱"、"冲浪赚钱"、 "网络游戏赚钱"等等。你输入"网络赚钱"这个关键词,在互联网上可以搜索到几十万乃至几百 万条信息。但是,如果你真的想通过网络赚钱,还要谨慎选择,因为这其中不乏鱼目混珠的骗局。
