A new study suggests that very young children who watch a lot of television may have attention problems later in school. Children with attention problems cannot sit still or control their actions. They talk too much, lose things, forget easily and are not able to finish tasks.

People with attention problems may suffer a condition known as Attention Deficit Disorder (注意力不足症), or A. D. D.. Some education researchers have been saying for years that watching television at a very young age could change the normal development of the brain. For example, they say that children who watch a lot of television are not able to sit and read for an extended period of time.

The new study tested the idea that television watching by very young children is linked to attention problems by the age of seven. There were two groups of children, ages one and three. Researchers asked the parents how often the children watched television.

The children who watched a lot of television at an early age were most likely to have attention problems. Every hour of watching television increased the chances of having attention problems by about 10%. For example, children who watched three hours a day were 30% more likely to have attention problems than those who watched no television.

The researchers say that all the children with attention problems might not have A. D. D. But they still could face major learning problems in school. The findings support the advice from a group of children's doctors that children under the age of two should not watch television.

One of the researchers says there are other reasons why children should not watch television. Earlier studies have linked it with children becoming too fat and too aggressive (好挑逗的). Other experts say the new study is important, but more work needs to be done to confirm the findings and better explain the cause and effect.

Beijing is determined to build a complete renewable resource recycling network in the years to come so that 30 percent of the trash (废物) in the city can be recycled before 2008.

In accordance with a plan regarding the promotion, standardization and construction of a renewable resource recycling network in the urban districts of Beijing, 1,800 recycling stations will be established in the eight urban districts of the city, of which 1,400 will be constructed in 2002 and 2003.

"The plan has been developed jointly by nine departments of the Beijing Municipal Government," said local sources.

According to the sources, 56 new recycling trucks will be put into operation throughout the eight urban districts this year to replace the former fleet. To promote the construction of a sound recycling network for renewable resources, Beijing will make efforts to sort trash and transform the practice into a systematic practice in 250 residential (住宅的) quarters. Varying amounts of subsidies, with the highest amounting to 60,000 yuan (about 7,228 US dollars), will be given to residential sectors which effectively implement the trash sorting practice.

The Beijing Municipal Commission of Commerce will soon draw up a plan to establish markets for the collection and distribution of renewable resource in an effort to overcome the rather confused (混乱的) situation at present.

According to the plan, the city will build ten standardized renewable resource markets.

Statistics show that the urban districts of Beijing currently produce one million tons of trash each year, of which wasted paper accounts for 13.33 percent and waste glass 6.5 percent. Recycled paper is principally used for printing business cards, textbooks and postcards.

The SEED School in Washington, D. C., provides an intensive educational program in a boarding school environment. Students live at a boarding school. The SEED School is one of the few public boarding schools in the country.

It opened in nineteen ninety-eight. It is a modern, high-technology school in the poorest part of the District of Columbia. Most of the students are black. Often they have grown up in areas of poverty and crime.

SEED officials say the school provides a safe and secure environment twenty-four hours a day. The educational program is designed to prepare students for college. The boarding program is designed to help them learn life skills.

School representatives work with local teachers and the community to identify students who could be helped by the school. Parents and children decide together if the SEED program is the best educational choice for them. It is not for everyone. Students enter the program in the seventh grade. They agree to stay for six years.

The goal is to prepare them for success in college and in future employment. This means that learning continues after classes are over for the day. School officials say the students receive family and community support. They learn about personal responsibility. They learn to balance work and play. They can help teach younger students, or do community service. The school also offers sports and social activities.

The SEED School currently has more than three hundred students. So far, two classes have completed the program. School officials say all of the young people were accepted at universities.

The SEED School is a charter school. This means it is privately operated but receives public money. Private gifts also help pay for the school.

There were some important supporters and guests in the school. In November, Britain's Prince Charles and his wife, Lady Camilla, spent an afternoon with First Lady Laura Bush.

Despite IM's increasing popularity, e-mail is still the biggest reason teens go online, followed by visits to entertainment websites, playing games and getting news. Instant messaging comes in fifth.

Allan goes everywhere with Brigitte Anderson, a 54-year-old secretary. He moves around her office at work and goes shopping with her. "Most people don't seem to mind Allan," says Brigitte, who thinks he is wonderful. "He's my fourth child," she says. She may think of him and treat him that way, buying him food, paying his health bills and his taxes; but in fact Allan is a dog.

Brigitte and Allan live in Sweden, a country where everyone is expected to lead an orderly life according to rules laid down by the government, which also provides a high level of care for its people. This level of care costs money.

People in Sweden pay taxes on everything, so they aren't surprised to find that owning a dog means yet more taxes. Some people are paying as much as 500 Swedish kronor in taxes a year for the right to keep their dog, money that is spent by the government on dog hospitals and sometimes medical treatment for a dog that falls ill. However, most such treatment is expensive, so owners often decide to pay health and even life insurance for their dogs.

In Sweden dog owners must pay for any damage their dogs do. A Swedish Kennel Club official explains what this means: if your dog runs out on the road and gets hit by a passing car, you, as the owner, have to pay for any damage done to the car, even if your dog has been killed in the accident.

Noah's Ark (诺亚方舟) has set sail again. Crossing stormy scientific waters, today's ark is not carrying animals two by two safely. Rather, it could produce unlimited numbers of presently endangered animals.

Noah is the name given in advance to the clove (克洛芙) of a dead gaur, a rare type endangered wild ox found in India, Bangladesh and Southeast Asia. The new Noah is expected to be born any day now to Bessie, a cow living on a farm in Iowa. Cows have given birth to gaurs before, but Advanced Cell Technologies, a small biotechnology (生物技术) company in Massachusetts, is using a cross-species nuclear-transfer technique to clone a different species (物种).

Bessie's ultrasound (超声波) tests look good, but is the concept a sound one? Robert Lanza, ACT's vice president of medical and scientific development, says that technique "presents exciting possibilities" that may help rescue endangered species. Other scientists argue that such ways are unlikely to make an important contribution to the support of the endangered species, especially if their habitats (栖息地) have been destroyed.

If Bessie's little gaur is delivered safely, the birth will come as an encouragement to many biologists in the US and Europe who are engaged. In particular, though, Noah's arrival will hearten the scientists at ACT, who recently signed a deal with Spanish officials to attempt to clone the bucardo, an extinct (灭绝的) mountain goat native to the Pyrenees Mountains. The last bucardo died a year ago. Scientists had already kept a quantity of its cells, and ACT hopes to transfer them into other goats' eggs some time soon.

It may be the season to be joyful at the time of Christmas, but a psychologist in Columbus, Ohio says as many as one person in four has a chance of holiday depression (抑郁) this time of year.

Dr. David Lowenstein says a lot of people "buy into the idea that the holidays should be a picture perfect. Norman Rockwell affair", but he says that's "unrealistic for most people". Dr. Lowenstein says the potential is very high this time of year for psychological, physical and financial stress, so he recommends applying what he calls the "three R's" to keep back the holiday blues.

The doctor says a lot of people can't spend what they'd like on gifts, or they spend more than they can afford. Either way, he says, is depressing.

Third, get some Rest. Don't try to do more than you can comfortably do. Watch your time, and schedule some breaks for peace and quiet. Also, share your load with someone else. Dr. Lowenstein says if you're feeling stressed and / or overburdened, try to get relatives or friends to help take up some of your burdens.
