## 前言

长期以来,有许多考生记忆单词的数量不少,却很难在考试中夺得高分,本书旨在帮助你解决这一问题。记最常用的词,学最实用的词,考最理想的分。

本书以最新的《研究生入学考试英语考试大纲》为依据,参照大学英语四、六级考试大纲,精心编写而成。

每部分按字母顺序排列单词,根据不同情况提供每个单词的[词义]、[同义]、[反义]、[辨析]、[词组]、[典型考题]、[试题分析]、[真题实例]、[派生]等项。
