开始谈话时态度要友好,可以陈述事实,也可以问问题,但话题不要太偏、太私人化。与英美等西方人相见,我们可以用"Hi!"/"Hello!"等寒暄语开场,也可以用很讲究的开场语开始交谈,如"Excuse me, is anybody sitting here?"/"Say, don't I know you from somewhere?"/"Sorry, I couldn't help overhearing—did you mention something about...?"/"Excuse me, have you got a light?"/"Uh, could you help me? I'm looking for..."。天气是常见的话题,因为谈天气不会冒犯任何人,但回答时注意不要顶撞对方。开场时还可以从有关家庭、朋友、工作、学校或体育话题开始,但不要涉及收人、女士年龄、宗教、政治等问题。
