内容提要

本书为《中级英语测试指导》系列书之一,根据当今高考英语对语法考试的要求以及现行高中英语课程需求而设计编成。旨在通过典型实题的强化训练,力争快速有效地提高学生的语法运用能力与应试成绩。

全书共分两大部分:第一部分为语法专项练习,由9个单元组成,每单元配有高考英语语法指导以及50 道语法专项训练题。第二部分为语法综合练习,由30 套综合练习题组成,每套配有50 道语法训练题。

本书共收录了近2000 道语法练习题,其中大部分模拟选择题是作者根据近年来高考英语语法命题的新理念,采用真实情景和真实材料精心改写或刻意模仿而成的,另有小部分习题选自海内外最新英语语法题,还有一些练习题选自最近几年上海和全国高考英语语法题。因而本书具有相当高的实用参考价值。

前 言

本书根据全日制高级中学英语课程标准和高考中对英语语法的要求编写而成,旨在通过英语语法测试训练,培养学生运用英语的能力,并切实有效地提高学生的应试能力。

全书分成两大部分:第一部分为语法专项练习,由 9 个单元组成,每个单元配有高考英语语法测试指导以及 50 道语法专项练习题。第二部分为语法综合练习,由 30 套综合练习题组成,每套综合练习配有 50 道语法练习题。本书共收录了近 2 000 道语法练习题,其中百分之六十是编者从近几年原版英文杂志文章中摘录句子,经过精心改写编制而成。这部分语法选择题是对最近几年高考英语语法题的刻意模仿,体现了近年来高考英语语法命题的新理念:命题者多采用真实情景和真实材料来编制试题。百分之三十五的习题选自海内外新颖英语语法题。百分之五的习题(其中包括测试指导中的例题)选自这几年来上海以及全国高考英语语法题。

本书由复旦大学黄关福教授主编,上海市杨浦高级中学徐志江承担了主要的编写工作。 上海市杨浦高级中学朱静涛参与编写了部分习题。在编写过程中,复旦大学出版社唐敏和 计美娟同志为本书的出版做了不少工作,谨致谢意。

由于时间匆促和水平所限,书中难免存在差错和不妥之处,敬请读者不吝指正。
