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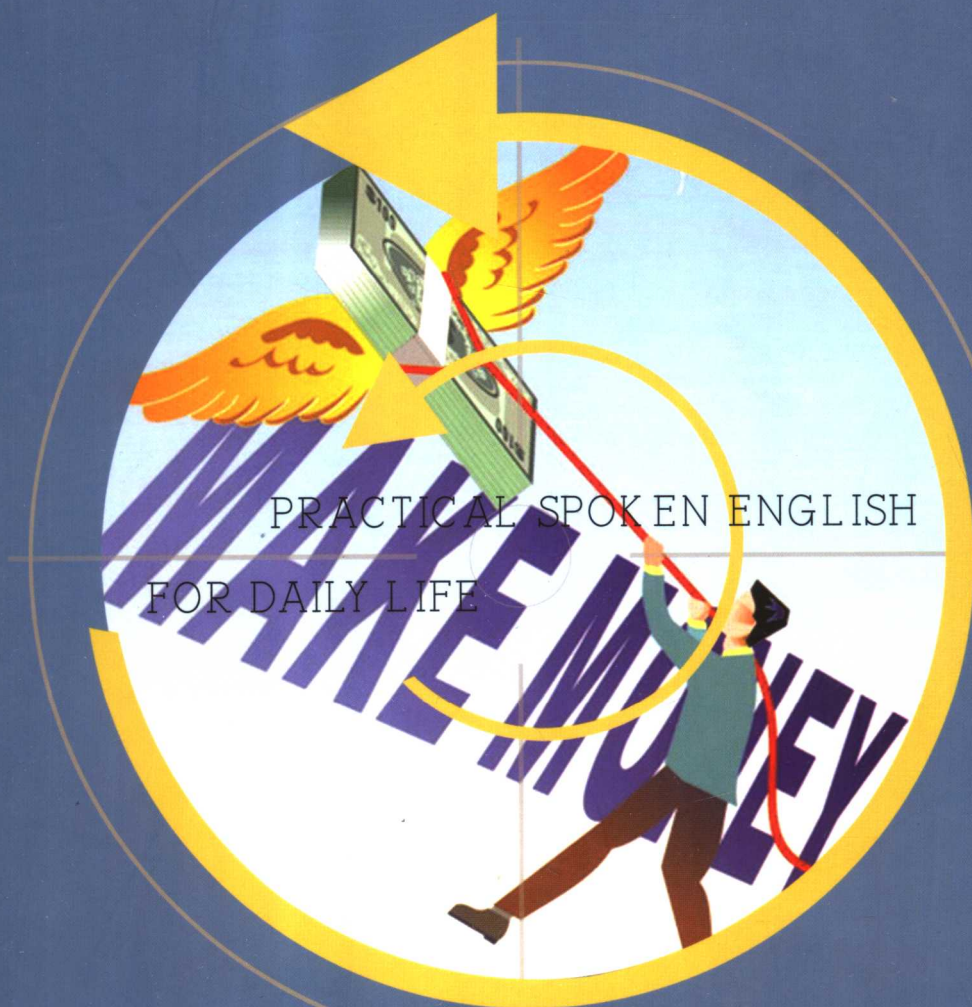

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出版 说明

为了进一步贯彻落实《国务院关于大力推进职业教育改革与发展的决定》和全国职业教育工作会议的精神,适应高等职业教育发展的要求,满足国际贸易专业教学的实际需要,我们组织编写了“十一五”高职高专规划教材国际贸易系列丛书。该系列丛书涵盖了高职高专国际贸易专业教学中的主干专业课程(包括国际贸易、进出口贸易实务、国际金融实务、国际贸易地理、国际贸易地理学习指导、外贸函电、西方经济学、国际商法、出口单证实务、国际市场营销、实用日常英语口语),从2006年秋季开学起,这些教材将陆续提供给各高职院校国际贸易专业使用。

该系列教材是根据高职高专国际贸易专业的教学培养目标而编写的。该教材从社会对国际贸易人才的需求出发,在内容上结合本专业岗位对职业能力的要求来确定教材的出发点、技能点和素质要求点,注重对学生的创新能力和实践能力的培养。该系列教材在理论体系、组织结构和阐述方法等方面均作了一些新的尝试,以适应高职高专教学改革的需要。

该系列教材由安徽国际商务职业学院牵头编写,参加组织编写的院校包括合肥工业大学、安徽财贸职业学院、万博科技职业学院、淮南职业技术学院、芜湖信息技术职业学院、安徽工业经济职业技术学院、安徽冶金科技职业学院、安徽国防科技职业学院、合肥经济技术职业学院、淮南联合大学、安徽农业大学涉外经济学院、安徽经济技术学校等。同时,在该教材的编写和出版过程中,也得到了安徽省教育厅的大力支持。

前言

随着大学英语教学改革的深入,突破“哑巴英语”,解决学生开口难、交流难的现状,提高学生的口语表达能力,已经成为大学英语教学中亟待研究和探讨的一个课题。要大幅度地提高口语课的教学效果和教学质量,必须有一本适合学生水平和兴趣的教材。目前市场上的口语书不少,其中不乏上乘之作,但适合课堂教学的口语教材不多,适合职业院校这一层次学生学习的口语教材更是凤毛麟角。为了填补这一遗憾,我们组织了部分有口语教学经验的老师编写了这本日常口语教材。

这本口语教材在编写过程中力求体现以下几个特色:

(1) 每个单元以大学学生的学习和生活为主线,围绕情景或符合学生需要和兴趣的跨文化主题展开。

(2) 情景设置、技能要求和跨文化主题选择紧扣大纲;同时兼顾到语言的规范性、材料的知识性、趣味性和时效性。

(3) 活动组织形式多样,把句型练习融入诸如完成对话、复述故事、看图说话、小组讨论等多种形式的课堂活动中,以期使学生达到熟练运用句型的目的,使教师能较轻松地将口语课组织得有声有色且富有成效。

(4) 与各单元主题和大学生生活密切相关的热点话题讨论能解决学生日常生活中的一些困惑,激发学生深入思考。

(5) 教材中设计的文化小贴士和一些交际活动体现了跨文化交际的因素,使学生在学语言的过程中了解到不同国家的文化和风土人情。

本教材由龙梅和凌双英老师担任主编,程晓莉、张咏梅和杨茂老师担任

副主编，具体分工如下：龙梅（第1、第5、第8、第11、第12和第13单元）、张咏梅（第2、第4、第10、第16和第19单元）、程晓莉（第3、第6、第7和第9单元）、杨茂（第14、第15、第17、第18和第20单元）。全书由龙梅老师统稿和总纂，安娜老师担任主审，通读了全文并提出了宝贵的意见。本书在编写过程中还得到了安徽国际商务职业学院张卿副院长的大力支持，在此表示感谢。

Jack: The world is really small... Oh, what a lovely day, today! Hate to stay on the campus.

Lily: Right. What about going out for an outing with us?

Jack: Why not? Where are you going?

Wang Hai: Xiangshan Park.

Jack: Terrific! I have heard it is very nice.

Wang Hai: It is. We'd better get going.

Lily: Not too long, just one hour.

Wang Hai & Lily: OK, let's go.

Jack: Fine, just fine. And you?

Ma Lin: Not too bad! It is really great to see you again. By the way, do you two know each other?

Jack: No, I don't think we do.

Ma Lin: Well, this is my good friend, Zhang Hua.

Jack: Glad to meet you. I'm Jack.

Zhang Hua: The same to you, Jack. I've heard a lot about you.

Zhang Hua: The Civil Engineering.

Jack: That sounds great! What class are you in?

Zhang Hua: I'm a sophomore. And you?

Jack: I came here to study Chinese. I'm afraid I must be going now.

Ma Lin: Well, talk to you later then. Oh, and give my love to Wang Hai.

Jack: I will.

Zhang Hua: It's been really nice to know you.

Jack: Hope to see you again! See you!

Ma Lin & Zhang Hua: Bye-bye.
