总 序

全国英语等级考试 (Public English Test System, 简称 PETS) 是在教育部考试中心精心设计下, 在英国国际发展部的资助以及英国剑桥大学地方考试委员会的大力支持下, 于 1999 年 6 月向社会正式推出的含有五个级别的英语考试体系。同年 9 月在北京、天津、山东、辽宁、浙江、湖北和广东等 10 个省、市开考, 报考总人数达到 28,577 人。2003 年首次在全国各省市进行考试, 考生人数达 46 万。2004 年考生人数增加到 69.7 万, 2005 年则达到 87 万人。随着时间的推移, 从数字上看, 参加英语等级考试的人数越来越多, 从社会认可度看, PETS 逐渐成为在我国最具影响力和权威性的英语类考试体系之一。

本套丛书是为适应我国正在进行的英语教育教学体系全面改革、新的题型考试体系广泛展开, 对英语教学的要求越来越高的形势下而编写的一套全新的适应新形势的考试指导丛书。

本套丛书的编写充分体现了 PETS 所设计的目标和宗旨。其测试重点是考察考生语言使用能力, 并从培养考生英语听、说、读、写、译的综合能力上为 PETS 考生提供了一个学习、应试和操练的平台。丛书的编者们基于多年大学英语、研究生英语以及 PETS 教学经验, 凭借担任 PETS 口语考官和考试辅导教师的经历, 对每一级别、每一项目考试的内容都进行了认真、科学的研究和探索, 寻找素材, 认真编写, 精心加工, 切中要点, 力图使之成为一套有较高实用价值、有一定的权威性且受益于考生的应试指导丛书。

本套丛书立足于研究历年考试规律, 预测未来考试趋势, 并严格以教育部考试中心颁布的各级《全国英语等级考试大纲》为依据, 客观准确地反映考试大纲的要求。根据中国学生学习英语的特点, 紧扣大纲规定的考点, 设计多主题且内容丰富的试卷, 目的是使考生明确考试要求, 反复练习, 增强自信, 最终达到事半功倍、顺利通过 PETS 考试的目标, 并且能在学习的过程中使英语综合能力得到全面提高。

本套丛书具有以下特点:

1. 每一级别设计编写了对大纲要求和考试题型所做的分析, 总结学习方法、学习

重点和难点，考题特点以及应试策略。

2. 根据口试的真实情景，针对每一级别分别设计编写了若干套标准模拟口试试卷，其难度与 PETS 各级别口语考试难度相当，并配有口试应试指导。

本套丛书的编者们怀着为英语教学改革和考试体系改革略尽绵力的心情，承担为普及英语教学、培养多层次英语人才的责任，集思广益，通力合作，编写了这套可供各级考生使用的全国英语等级考试考点通解及模拟试卷丛书。由于时间较紧，难免有疏漏之处，真诚希望广大师生和读者提出宝贵的批评与建议，以使这套丛书在今后的修订中得到改进和完善。

全国英语等级考试第三级

口试技巧与应试指导

第一节 口试题型介绍

PETS 三级的口试由 Part 1、Part 2、Part 3 三部分构成。测试考生用英语进行口头交际的能力。

Part 1 是考官与考生进行交流。PETS 的口试主考官用标准英语和考生分别进行对话，采用问答的形式。每个考生有大约 1.5 分钟的时间回答问题，问题多涉及考生的个人信息、考生的经历以及考生对未来的打算等。

Part 2 是两个考生共同进行讨论。两位考生之间就考官提供的图片或文字进行对话，采用交流的形式。每个考生有大约 1.5 分钟的时间与对方交换信息、表达观点、提出建议。

Part 3 是考生分别陈述各自的思想。考生就考官提供的图片或文字进行描述或阐述自己的观点，采用独自持续表达的形式。每个考生有大约 1.5 分钟的时间对事物做描述或就观点做论证。

口试满分为 5 分，3 分（含 3 分）以上为及格。

如果考生数是奇数，最后一场的口试就会有三个考生同时进行。这时，时间会作相应延长，提问方式也略有不同。在模拟试题中我们专门设置了一套三个考生同时口试的情景。

第二节 口试过程

每次口试有两名考官就坐，一名主考官负责与考生交谈并评分，另一名副考官不参与交谈，只进行评分。

每次口试一般有两名考生同时入场。

主考官先与 A 考生交流 1.5 分钟，再与 B 考生交流 1.5 分钟；然后 A、B 考生就

考官提供的信息卡彼此交流 3 分钟；最后考官先为 A 考生提供新信息卡，要求 A 考生先独自讲述 1.5 分钟，B 考生就同一话题再做 0.5 分钟的简短评论；接着考官再为 B 考生提供新信息卡，要求 B 考生独自讲述 1.5 分钟后，A 考生再就同一话题做 0.5 分钟的简短评论。

口试整个过程 10 分钟。

如果是三个考生就是 15 分钟。

第三节 口试临场技巧

口试是学生和老师面对面的交流，临场发挥很重要。

1. 无论面对什么样的考官、谈论什么样的话题都不要紧张。
 2. 举止礼貌，目光正视考官或同伴，两手不要有小动作。
 3. 发音到位、吐字清楚、自然流畅、不要装作。
 4. 不要有口头禅。
 5. 用词准确、语法正确、努力使用复杂一些的句子。
 6. 与同伴交流要不卑不亢，稳住阵脚。
- 阐述要有条有理，不要言不由衷、语不达意。

第四节 口试应试策略

口语和听力一样是中国学生的弱项，学生的口语甚至比听力还要弱。因此，要想考好口试，考生需要做一些专门的针对性的操练。下面就一些常考话题我们进行了一些设计，供考生平时练习。

1. 自我介绍

1) Family:

How many people are there in your family?

Do you have any brothers and sisters?

Are you the only child in your family?

What's your father's job?

What does your mother do?

How old is your mother (or your father)?

What do you often do in the evening?

Are you married or single?

Where do you live?

2) School:

Which school are you in?

What is your school like?

How far is your school from your home?

How do you go to school everyday?

What about your teachers in school?

How do you like the life in your school?

Do you eat in school or at home?

What about the food in school?

Do you live in school or at home?

3) Study:

What is your major?

How do you like your major?

Why did you choose your major?

Which subject do you like most?

How many hours do you spend on your study every day?

Besides the subjects in school, what else do you like to learn?

What do you think of the training in school?

Do you think your major will be useful in the future?

4) Hometown:

Where are you from?

What is the weather like in your hometown?

What do you think of the people of your hometown?

What place in your hometown do you like best?

What are the advantages and disadvantages of living in your hometown?

Are there any famous sceneries in your hometown?

How often do you go back to your hometown?

Who, in your family, are now living in your hometown?

5) Work

Where do you work?

How do you go to work?

How long does it take to go to work?

When do you go to work every day?

Do you like your job?

Why do you choose your job?

Do you plan to change your job?

Tell us something about your job?

6) Life:

Do you live with your parents or live in your own family?

What do you often do in your free time?

What films do you like?

How many hours do you watch TV every day?

How do you keep fit?

Do you go to the doctor regularly for a normal check?

How do you plan your finance?

Do you have a habit of surfing on the net?

例 1. (选自大纲口试样题)

Part 1 (3 minutes)

Interlocutor:

Good morning (afternoon). My name is..., and this is my colleague... He / she is just going to be listening to us.

And your names are ... and ...?

Give me your mark sheets, please.

Thank you.

(Hand over the mark sheets to the assessor.)

First of all we'd like to know something about you, Candidate A, so I'm going to ask you some questions.

Hometown

Either: (for candidates from other provinces)

- Where did you live before you came here?
- How long have you lived here?
- How do you like it? Why?
- Do you think you will live here forever? Why?

Or: (for candidates taking the examination locally)

- Do you live near here? Whereabouts?
- What do you think are the good points about living here?
- How do you usually go to work / school? Why?

Thank you. Now, we'd like to know something about you, Candidate B, so I'm going to ask you some questions.

Family

- Could you tell me something about your family?
- What does your family usually do for the weekend?
- Do you enjoy it? Why?
- What do you think about living together with parents / by yourself?

Thank you.

【解析】 口语考试不同于笔试，答案不可能是唯一。所以我们只能对样题的问题提供一部分参考答案，每个考生可以根据自己的思想给出自己的答案。

首先，考生应该和考官打招呼；其次对考官提问的问题逐一回答。这里问到家乡和家庭，考生就应该根据自己的家乡和家庭进行回答

【参考答案】

Candidate A:

- In Beijing.
- For ten years.
- Very much.

- No, because after my graduation I will go to some other places to work.

Or:

- Yes, near the Tiananmen Square.
- We have fresh air, clean water, and good education.
- I go to work by bus. Because I have no private car, and my work is far away.

Candidate B

- We have a big family: my grandparents, my parents and I.
- Go out to the park.
- Not always, because they are less active than me.
- Living with parents is a good way to help the family to know each other better, and to help each other better.

What do you think is most important when eating out?

5) Sports

Do you like sports? Why?

What sports do you like to do in your pastime?

How often do you do these sports?

Why do you like them?

6) Pet

Do you like pets?

What's the reasons?

What's the other family members' attitude towards pet?

7) Work

What do you do?

Do you like your work? Why?

How long have you been working?

Do you work to live or live to work?

8) Money

Do you think money is important in your life?

What will you do with it if you had one million dollars?

How much money is enough for you?

Do you think money will always get you happy?

9) Music

What type of music do you like best?

Who is your favorite singer?

Do you like background music in shops or restaurants?

Do you listen to music while studying?

10) Collection

Do you like collection?

What do you like to collect?

Do you spend a lot of time on collection?

How much time do you usually spend?

11) Hobby

What are your hobbies?

Generally speaking, how long will you spend on your hobbies every week?

What do you learn from all the activities you take part in?

12) E-mail

How often do you send your letters or information by way of e-mails?

Don't you think that e-mails can change and influence your way of thinking and life style?

Which way do you like best if you want to send pictures, news, information and articles to your relatives and friends?

13) Travel

Which country do you like the best to travel?

When you take a trip, would you prefer Europe or the America?

What will you do before you make a long and wonderful journey?

例 2. (选自大纲口试样题)

Part 2 (3 minutes)

Interlocutor:

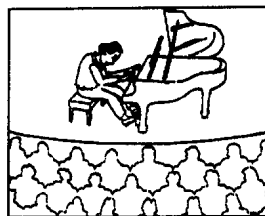
Now, I'd like you to talk about something for about 3 minutes. I'm just going to listen.

I'd like you to imagine that you are going out for an evening's entertainment.

(Place picture sheet in front of candidates.)

This is the picture sheet for you two. The picture shows four kinds of performances:

1. pop music concert;
2. Peking Opera;
3. ballet dancing;
4. a pianist playing.



I'd like you to talk to each other about the sort of entertainment you like best. It is not necessary for you to agree with each other. You have only about 3 minutes for this, so don't worry if I stop you and please speak clearly so that we can hear you. All right?

Candidates: (Discuss the subject for approximately 3 minutes.)

Interlocutor: Thank you. (Retrieve the picture sheet.)

【解析】 本题需要考生互相就图片讨论自己的观点。每个人的喜好都不一样，我们这里只是大体上给出一个参考。

四个图画是流行音乐会、京剧、芭蕾舞、钢琴演奏。考生根据自己的平时感受发表意见，但这四种娱乐活动除去流行音乐外都是高雅的娱乐，有的考生未必曾经有过亲身体验。这时考生可以避重就轻，选自己较为熟悉的。

【参考答案】

Candidate A: Well, let me see. I think my favorite entertainment is pop music. You know pop music is easy to understand and easy to learn.

Candidate B: Sorry, I don't agree with you. I think you can't like something just because it is easy. I like the piano playing. I have learned it for nearly ten years.

Candidate A: You know a piano is very expensive, not everyone can afford it. Besides, to play the piano needs a certain gift. For example, if your

fingers are not long enough you'd better not learn the piano.

Candidate B: We don't have to be a so-called pianist, we just develop a kind of liking.

Candidate A: But what would you do if your family is not rich enough? So I think pop music is for all the people, poor or rich, old or young.

Candidate B: But we still need soothing besides pop music.

3. 讲述

这部分所涉及的话题和 Part 2 的话题基本一致，多是一些社会、文化等内容。但考试的方式是让学生独立描述，考生回答的方式不再是与伙伴进行讨论，而是自己构思出一段长达 1.5 分钟的微型演讲。

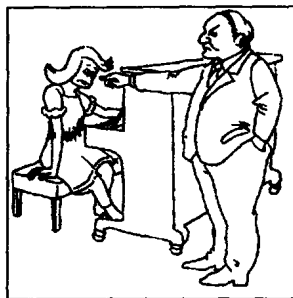
Part 3 (4 minutes)

Interlocutor:

Now, I'd like each of you to talk on your own for about one and a half minutes. I'm going to give each of you a different picture and I'd like you to talk about it. Candidate A, here is your picture: a little girl unwillingly playing the piano; her father standing in front of her with a long face. Please let Candidate B have a look at it.

(Hand over the picture to Candidate A.)



Candidate A, I'd like you to describe the picture and tell us what you think about it. Remember you have only about one and a half minutes for this, so don't worry if I interrupt you, all right?

Candidate A: (Discuss the subject for approximately one and a half minutes.)

Interlocutor:

Thank you. (Retrieve the picture sheet.)
