前 言

近年来,高职高专开办英语专业的院校逐年增多,但适合高职高专院校学生 英语程度的口语教材并不多。为此,我们编写了二十一世纪全国高职高专英语系 列教材《英语口语教程》,由上、下两册组成。该教程内容涉及情景对话、课堂讨论、 演讲及辩论等,涵盖了出国生活的各种场合,如寒暄、引见、问路、乘交通工具、银 行、旅店、餐馆、购物、看病、娱乐等。编者通过对学生进行循序渐进、全面系统的口 语训练,旨在提高学生进行一般日常活动、情景交往和从事一般性涉外业务活动的 英语口语表达能力,并为今后进一步提高英语实际应用能力打下坚实的基础。

该教程内容丰富,结构清晰,语言生动,形式活泼,充分体现了口语教学形式的 灵活性。本册分为10个单元。每个单元均由四部分组成,包括情景对话、故事复述、情景对话固定句型及英语口语常用句型。在第一部分中,通过情景对话具体地展示了各种语言功能是如何在交谈中体现的,并对于会话中的生词、难点进行了注释;第二部分的故事复述可以激发学生学英语、说英语的兴趣;第三部分的固定句型有助于学生较好地巩固本单元的情景对话;在第四部分,笔者精心收集了999条英语口语常用句型,分布到各个单元,便于学生进行日常英语口语训练。本册设计课时为30个课时,各个学校亦可根据自己的实际情况自主安排学时。

这套书的编写是专门为高职高专(即普通高等专科教育、高等职业教育和成人高等专科教育)学生设计的,既可作为高职高专英语专业的教材,亦可用于英语口语学习者和从事涉外活动的人士以及各类英语口语培训班。

本册 1~2 单元由杜国荣编写,3~6、9~10 单元由郭松珍编写,7~8 单元由蒋海舰编写,全书由杜国荣教授主审。

由于编书时间仓促,难免有疏漏之处,望读者给予指正并予以原谅。
