PREFACE

Originally, the objective of this text was to consider the extent to which English private law responded to the problems posed by fraud. This would have involved an analysis of issues such as liability at common law for the tort of deceit and liability in equity for dishonest assistance. However, during its lengthy period of incubation, the focus became far wider due to a number of different factors. It became apparent that, in order to determine the extent to which problems presented by fraud have affected the development of the law, it would be necessary to provide an overview of the whole area of law in question. This was done and the civil law aspects of fraud can be found in Parts B and C of this text. But it also became clear that the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002, with its wide ranging provisions relating to money laundering offences and the pursuit of criminal proceeds, was too important to omit in a work which was intended to deal with fraud. Furthermore, in order to analyse the law properly—particularly the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002—a detailed exposition of the relevant aspects of human rights law was necessary. Finally, the civil law position is complicated by the fact that, in the latter half of the twentieth century, regulatory proceedings have become more significant. International conventions are also influencing, both directly and indirectly, the direction of domestic law in areas such as corruption and money laundering. The civil law applicable to individuals cannot realistically be studied in isolation. These matters are therefore dealt with in Part A. The result is a text which attempts to straddle many disparate areas of law and to find links between them.

Despite its breadth, this text does not aspire to cover every area in which fraudulent activity can be found. Unfortunately, fraud is forever with us. New laws may be passed to counter a particular type of misconduct but some form of deceit will then arise in a new form. The text is confined, as the title suggests, to fraud in commercial dealings. Even here, the boundaries have been difficult to draw. In this first edition, there is no discussion of the defences of undue influence, duress, and illegality; these subjects are admirably dealt with in existing texts, such as Andrew Burrows, *Law of Restitution* (2002). Furthermore, although the law of unjust enrichment is considered, it was impossible, given the scope of the text, to pursue issues in great detail. I am consoled by the fact that there are a number of outstanding texts, such as Goff and Jones, *The Law of Restitution* (2002) and P Birks, *Unjust Enrichment* (2003), as well as numerous

first rate articles to be found in the Restitution Law Review and other journals; the Restitution Discussion Group website, organised by Stephen Hedley, can be found at: <<http://www.ucc.iee/law/restitution/rdg>>.

I have tried to provide a straightforward and accessible account of complex areas of law. To this end, I have used an Engineering student, Anna Barwell, to proof read the chapters. I am grateful to Anna for her hard work. I would thank Lily Tomlinson for proof reading. I would also like to thank the team from Oxford University Press for their patience, hard work, and efficiency at the editing stage: Annabelle Macris, Senior Commissioning Editor, Meg Zawadzki, Commissioning Editor, Darcy Ahl, Production Editor, and Matt Smith, Editorial Assistant.
