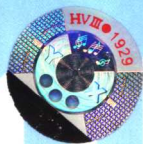

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前 言

本书是为高中各年级学生,尤其是高三学生编写的以英语听力测试为宗旨的训练手册。实践证明:英语听力的独特功能,对开展英语学科素质教育,提高学生英语的综合能力,起着十分重要的作用。

本书共编写 20 套高考英语听力模拟测试题。题型和题量均与 2006 年上海市英语高考听力试题相同,难易程度参照 2006 年上海市英语高考听力试题。
