## FOREWORD

The Gilbert Group of Islands was proclaimed a British Protectorate on 27th May 1892. By the Gilbert and Ellice Islands Order in Council 1915, which came into operation on 12th January 1916, the Gilbert Group and the Ellice Group of Islands were, in accordance with the desire of the Native Governments of those Islands, annexed to and together formed part of the British Dominions under the name of the Gilbert and Ellice Islands Colony. From time to time other Islands were added to the Colony.

On 1st October 1975 the Ellice Islands separated from the Colony and were established as a separate colony known as Tuvalu. Since then the Gilbert and Ellice Islands Colony has been known as the Gilbert Islands.

The Laws of the Gilbert Islands date from 1893 and have been previously consolidated in the Revised Editions of the Laws of the Gilbert and Ellice Islands of 1952 and 1973. This present Revised Edition, which is in 3 volumes, has been prepared in accordance with the Revised Edition of the Laws Ordinance (Cap. 92). It contains the Ordinances enacted before 1st January 1977 and several enacted after, full use having been made of the Law Revision Commissioner's power to include subsequent enactments.

There have been omitted the Ordinances and subsidiary legislation set out in the Schedule to the said Ordinance. The omitted provisions remain in force until they are repealed, revoked or replaced or become spent.

After the Ordinances there is a Supplement containing extracts from, and notes on, various United Kingdom enactments and orders of special interest, together with subsidiary legislation enacted under them in the Gilbert Islands.

This Revised Edition is in loose-leaf form, permitting it to be updated periodically as provided by the Revised Edition of the Laws Ordinance.

On 12th July 1979 the Gilbert Islands became a sovereign democratic Republic under the name of Kiribati.
