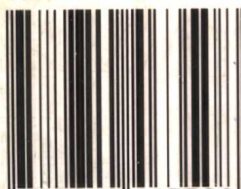
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前 言

使用建议

本书提供阅读材料 100 篇,其中第 1 至第 36 篇后附有两项练习,第 37 至第 100 篇后又增附第 3 项练习,目的是让学生在阅读一篇篇由浅入深的短文的同时,阅读水平和理解能力也循序渐进地提高。本书练习包括 3 大类:

I. 正误题:

这项练习主要是通过适当改变原句,保持句子原意不变或使句意完全改变,让学生对新句重新判断。目的在于检测学生对句子意思的理解程度,同时培养学生细心阅读的好习惯。

II. 选择题:

这项练习主要让学生在理解单个句子的基础上,结合上下文弄懂句子的含义。目的在于检测学生对语篇事实的总体了解程度,同时提高学生的分析能力。

III. 问答题:

从第 37 篇起,我们又增加了围绕故事情节的问答题。这项练习主要让学生在对话篇事实总体了解的基础上,进一步理解文章的含义,感受文章的幽默。目的在于训练学生的综合理解能力,培养思维习惯,为进一步学习和应用英语打下扎实的基础。

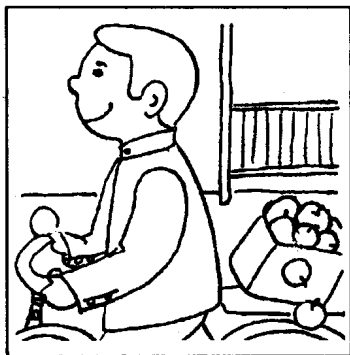

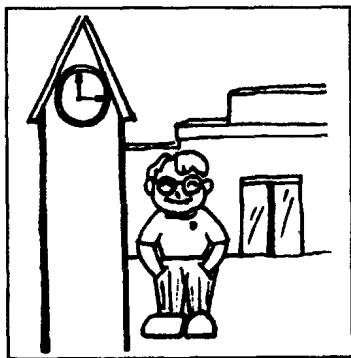

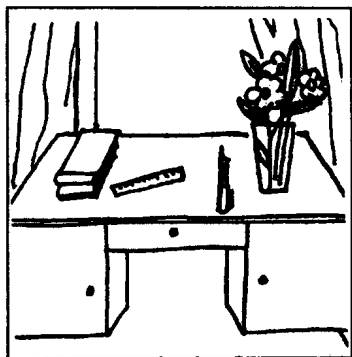
