Acknowledgements for Illustrations

The caption of each illustration that requires an acknowledgement includes the symbol §, printed after the figure number (for example, Fig. 28.57. §). A footnote on the page on which the first such illustration in each chapter appears refers the reader to the page on which the acknowledgements are made. In the lists of acknowledgements, all the illustrations from each source are grouped together, in numerical sequence. The different sources are acknowledged in separate paragraphs, arranged in the numerical order of the first figure that relates to each.

Some of the authors of the book and some of those who provided them with illustrations for the first volumes of this edition have found this method of acknowledgement to be inadequate. The § footnote, appearing only once in each chapter, is liable to be overlooked: this has led to a mistaken impression that acknowledgements have not been made in all instances requiring them.

The decision not to include acknowledgements in the captions of the illustrations but to collect them at the end of the chapters was made by the editor, who is responsible for the embarrassment caused to the authors and to those who helped to illustrate the book.
