大学英语六级考试是由教育部大学英语四、六级考试委员会组织实施的全国性标准化考试。该考试自 1989 年举行至今已有 16 年,受到了广泛的关注,对大学英语教学产生了深远的影响。为了适应新时期对大学生英语能力的要求,大学英语六级考试也在不断地进行改革,以便能更加全面地考查考生的语言应用能力,使他们的英语能力进一步提高,为加入了 WTO 的中国的改革开放事业贡献力量。为了帮助广大考生熟悉和适应大学英语六级考试的各种题型,我们特组织熟谙六级教学的教师编写了本书。

我们按照新近出版的《大学英语教学基本要求》和《考试大纲》的要求,参照历年考试真题,有针对性地分题型编写了配套练习,并配有几套模拟试卷和全真试卷。这样的安排有助于考生在考前集中时间和力量针对自己的薄弱环节进行复习,掌握正确的对策,提高学习效率。

另外,根据教育部最新出台的考试改革方案,听力理解部分与阅读理解部分将会大大增加(前者所占比例从 20%提高到 35%;后者调整为 35%)。因此,我们在听力中增加了长篇对话,在阅读部分增加了几篇较长的短文,这些题型在过去的六级考试中还没有出现。

六级考试是四级考试的深入,具体题型和应试技巧基本相同,因此"六级考试应试技巧"这一部分本书不再赘述,有兴趣的读者可以参阅本系列图书《大学英语四级新题型应试必备》(浙大版,主编黄建滨,29.80元)。

本书是集体合作的结晶,编者们大都是浙江大学工作在大学

英语教学第一线的教授或副教授,他们长期从事大学英语教学,对大学英语考试有深刻的了解,为浙江大学在历次大学英语考试中在全国名列前茅的通过率和优秀率作出过贡献。本书正是他们历年教学实践和辅导大学英语六级考试的经验总结。相信她的出版将会有助于大学生们的英语学习和英语综合能力的提高,并帮助他们在六级考试中取得更优异的成绩。应当指出的是,应试只是权宜,对于提高语言应用能力帮助是很有限的,绝不可能取代课堂教学。所以,我们希望本书的读者平时能在老师的指导下,通过课堂教学和课外自主学习,继续进一步打好语言基础,提高英语听、说、读、写、译的综合应用能力,从而达到社会对大学生英语应用能力的要求,成为21世纪中国改革开放的有用之材。

本书由黄建滨主编,王小游、盛跃东副主编,编者有:鲍泓、陈文娟(浙江工商大学)、傅政、马以容、吴越民(按姓氏汉语拼音为序,除说明者外均为浙江大学外语学院教师)。由于编写时间紧迫、编者水平有限,书中错误在所难免,恳请广大读者批评指正。
