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# 前言

## 1. 针对性强

## 2. 实用性强

《高等学校英语应用能力考试模拟训练试题集》（天津版）1-3册，以《新编实用英语》（天津版）1-3册教材为蓝本。第一册包括8套B级考试模拟训练试题。第二册包括4套B级考试模拟训练试题与4套A级考试模拟训练试题。第三册包括8套A级考试模拟训练试题。该模拟训练试题与《新编实用英语》（天津版）1-3册教材内容相结合，包括：词汇、短语、会话、写作、翻译、生活在天津等。
