

第三版序言

由"全国优秀教师"顾骏声教授主编的这本听力教材,从 1988年出版以来,得到了许多院校师生的认可,作为新生的 听力教材(与国家 4 级考试听力内容相衔接)常年选用,深受 欢迎。使用者普遍反映,该教材覆盖面宽、针对性强,使用效 果良好。

近年来,国家对 4、6 级考试在内容和形式上进行了调整。 为了适应这一变化,我们组织编者对本教材做了较大修订,增加了 Spot Dictation 等内容,并以全新面貌奉献给大家。

本书配套录音带由两位美籍外教朗读,语速规范,语音纯正。

前言

目前高等院校采用的《大学英语教学大纲》,反映了国家培养高级人才的要求和规格。原国家教委在批转《大纲》的通知中规定:对结束 4、6 级学习的学生进行统一的标准考试。为了适应分级教学和标准考试的需要,我们选编了英语分级标准考试系列录音教材。它包括《大学英语听力测验》(1~3级、4~6级)、《新题型·大学英语 4级考试指南》、《新题型·大学英语 4级考试模拟试题集》、《新题型·大学英语 6级考试模拟试题集》、《新题型·大学英语 6级考试模拟试题集》、《新题型·大学英语 4、6级语法指南》。

《大学英语听力测验》(1~3级)共有4盒录音磁带,内容包括:

- 1级听力实践 其中有80个单句,60组对话。题材为学生所熟悉,句子结构简单,基本上没有生词,语速每分钟约100词。语言点按先后次序相对集中。教师可按学生的实际情况,根据需要,每次操练5~10个单句或4~8组对话,放音2~3遍,使学生对发音、连读和口语化简缩词的读音以及各种语法现象和语言内容,通过声响来辨别理解。
- **2 级听力测验** 按照陕西省高等院校大学英语 2 级统考 大纲听力要求的模式,编写了 8 套模拟试题,每套题约 15 分

钟。各题之间的间歇为 15 秒钟,以供多项选择答题。题材为一般性文章,句子结构简单,没有生词。语速每分钟约 100词,相当于 VOA 电台慢速英语节目。各套模拟试题的形式相同,均有 4 个单句、3 组对话、一段短文和一篇听写填空。理解准确率以 70%为合格。

3级听力实践 这是《4级听力测验》的准备阶段,有3套模拟试题。参照全国大学英语4级统考试题的模式,每套试题有10组对话、3篇短文和一篇听写填空。题材为学生所熟悉,句子结构比较简单,基本上没有生词,语速每分钟约120词。教师可按学生的实际情况,根据需要,单项操练或综合测试。理解准确率以70%为合格。

在编选本教材的过程中,曾得到我校前校长蒋德明教授的大力支持。教育部公外编委委员、西安交大外语系潘能教授为全书作了审校,在此我们表示衷心的感谢。
