





## 前 言

目前高等院校采用的《大学英语教学大纲》，反映了国家培养高级人才的要求和规格。国家教委在批转《大纲》的通知中规定：对结束四、六级学习的学生进行统一的标准考试。为了适应分级教学和标准考试的需要，我们选编了英语分级标准考试系列录音教材。它包括《大学英语听力测验》(1~3级、4级、5~6级)、《大学英语四级统考指南》、《大学英语四级考试模拟试题集》、《大学英语六级考试模拟试题集》、《大学英语四、六级语法指南》。

《大学英语听力测验》(4级)有四盒录音磁带，包含12套听力测验题。每套时间为20分钟左右，共20题，分两部分。第一部分有10题，每题为一组对话，对话后有一问句。第二部分也有10题，分别按排在三篇听力材料之后，每篇后有若干问题。

本教材所提供的录音磁带语音、语调规范，语速及停顿间隔时间完全按《大纲》规定的指标。本套磁带特聘外籍专家采用英美两种语音录制，以利于提高学生听力的适应能力。

在编选本教材的过程中曾得到我校校长蒋德明教授的大力支持，外语系主任郝克琦教授为全书作了审校，李觉民老师积极提供素材，在此我们表示衷心的感谢！
