

PREFACE

This book has a new title for the Second Edition, but it continues to have the same purpose as before, to set out as much of the law relating to personal injury claims as can conveniently be included in a single volume.

The major change for this edition has been in the treatment of the Civil Procedure Rules, where a narrative discussion has replaced the reproduction of a substantial part of the Rules and practice directions dealing with general matters of civil procedure, since it is thought that practitioners are likely to have ready access to these materials from other sources, such as online services or *Blackstone's Civil Practice*, to which extensive cross-references have been provided. The rules relating to specific topics of particular relevance to personal injury claims have been retained. Other chapters have been updated or rewritten as the pace of change has demanded.

Again I express my thanks to the writers and colleagues who have, without knowing it, contributed to this book and to my brother, Dr Richard Barrie, for his help with the medical information. In particular I am grateful to those who have used the updating website, and those who have commented on the book or sent me news of developments in the world of personal injury claims.
