Draft papers were circulated in advance so that the workshops could dispense with detailed presentations and focus on commentary, constructive criticism and debate. Two meetings allowed time for reflection and the development of ideas and arguments, and further facilitated rigorous intellectual engagement. Each written-up draft chapter was subjected to extensive editorial review and revision. This methodology was designed to produce, not only individual essays of the highest quality, but also collective coherence across the volume as a whole, with multiple points of cross-referencing and intersection around the core theme of integrity in criminal process.
